Notice to all firms:

This Addendum is issued to modify, change, delete from, add to, explain or correct the original Request for Bid and is hereby made a part of RFB #90 2026-01. In case of conflict between the Request for Bid and this Addendum, this Addendum shall govern. It is the bidder's responsibility to pass this addendum information to all involved in the bid.

Questions & Answers

Question 1: Does Patio 1 need footings?

Answer 1: No

Question 2: Is the stump staying in the Patio 1 area?

Answer 2: No, the Contractor will be responsible for stump removal.

Question 3: The specifications state 5" concrete – does this require wire mesh.

Answer 3: The specifications state "Concrete patios shall be constructed with 5" reinforced concrete"

Question 4: Who is responsible for Utility Locates?

Answer 4: The specifications state the Contractor will provide proper utility locates. As this is private property, Dodge County has a firm that locates all private utilities. The fee for the private utility marking will be paid for by Dodge County.

Question 5: Are the footings supposed to be poured flush to the concrete?

Answer 5: The footings should be poured flush with the bottom of the concrete pad.

Question 6: Can the footings and the pad be poured all at once?

Answer 6: No

Question 7: For the footings, there is no start point on the plans, how do we know where to place the footings?

Answer 7: The exact footing location will be determined with the awarded contractor.

Question 8: How will the contractor get the concrete to the site for Patio 2?

Answer 8: A concrete truck will not be able to access the site directly. There is a parking lot and a paved path that the contractor will have to wheel in the concrete to the site from.

Question 9: Does the awarded contractor have to have background checks done for their employees?

Answer 9: No

Question 10: Do you have any projected quantities for this project?

Answer 10: The approximate dimensions are on Page 13 and 14 of the RFB. The measurements were to be field verified at the mandatory pre-bid meeting held on March 2, 2026, at 11:00 am.
