*A **Boerne ISD**, Spanish Immersion classroom is intentionally designed to create a rich, balanced bilingual learning environment.*

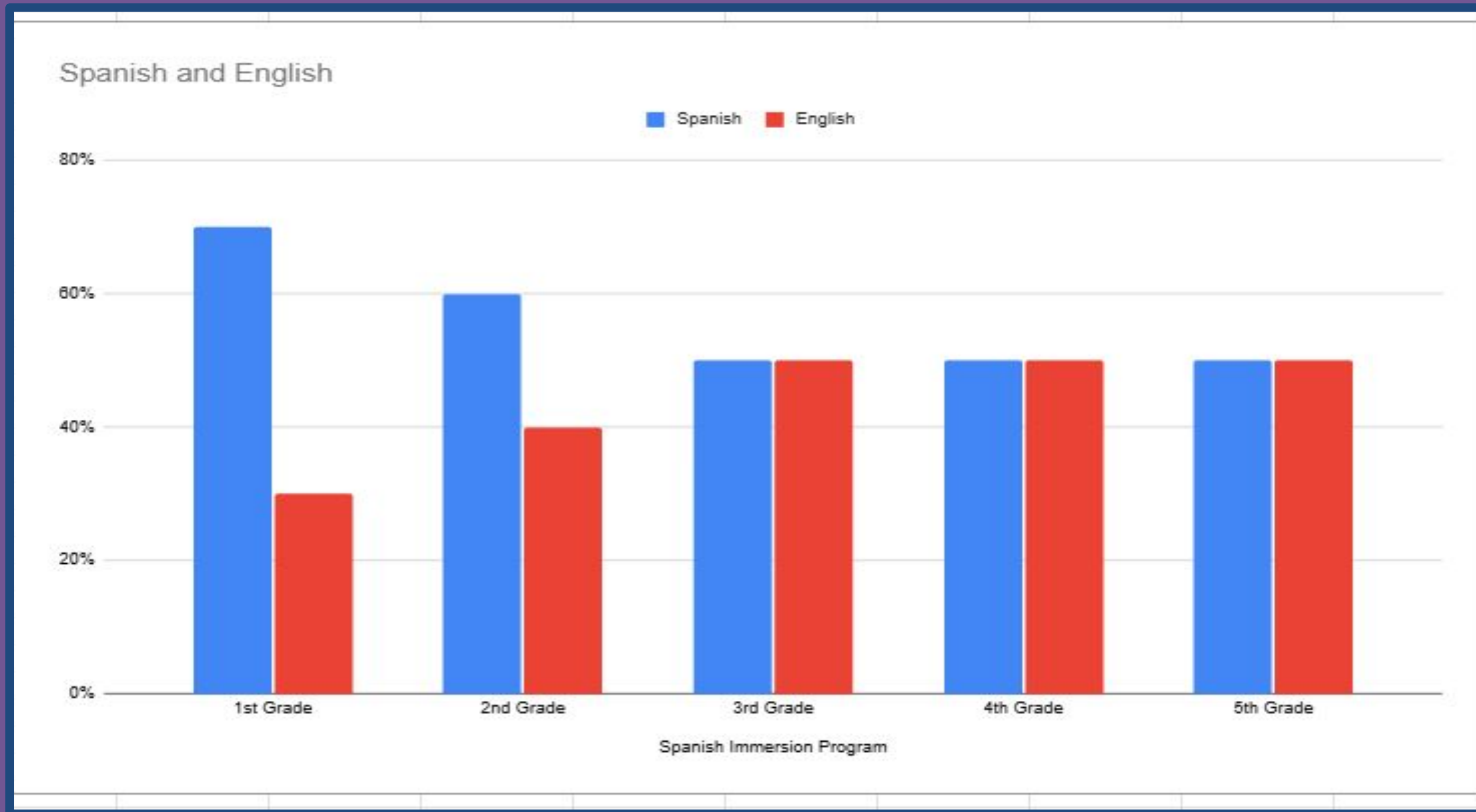
- Spanish Immersion is an enrichment language program for native English speakers (EPs) providing **academic content attainment** through Spanish and English beginning in First Grade.
- The building of classes is dependent on the number of **student allocations** per elementary campus.
- Spanish Immersion students are identified by **district approved enrollment procedures** and eligibility criteria.

This thoughtful design supports strong academic instruction, language development in both English and Spanish, and meaningful peer collaboration.



Language Distribution by Grade Level

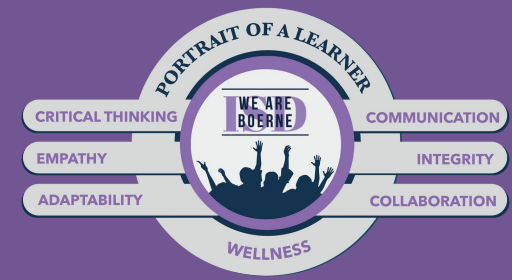
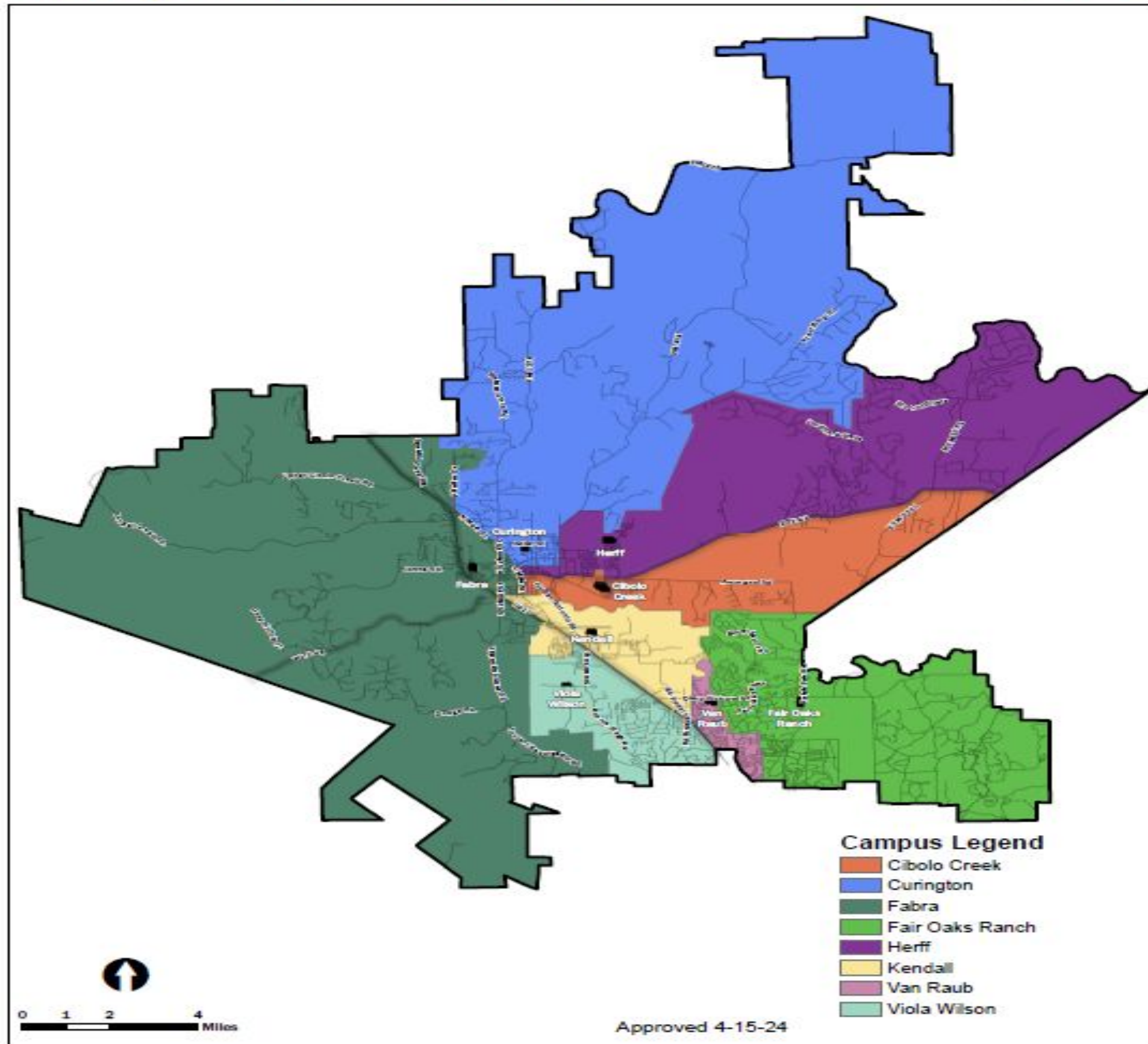
