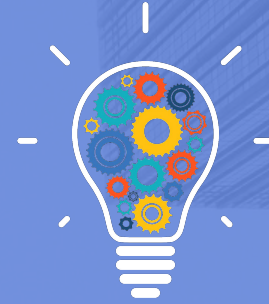

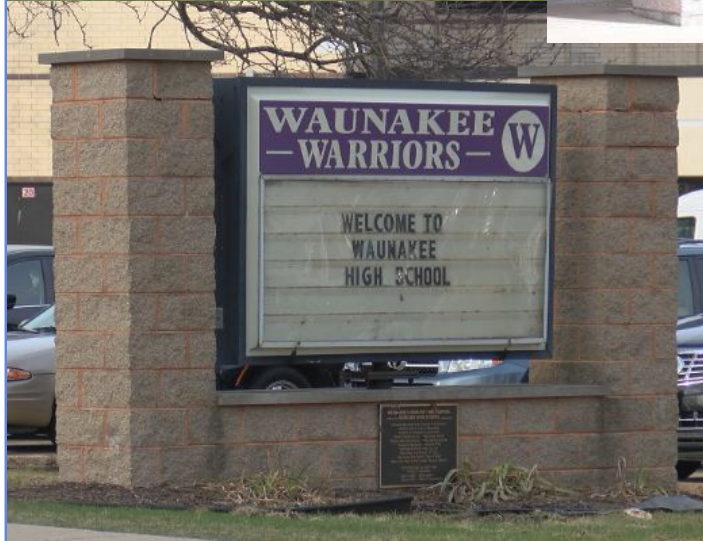

Figure out the structure and design needed for our monument to stand tall.

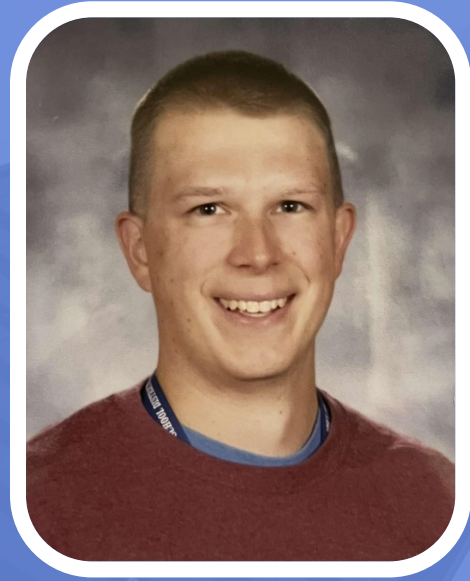

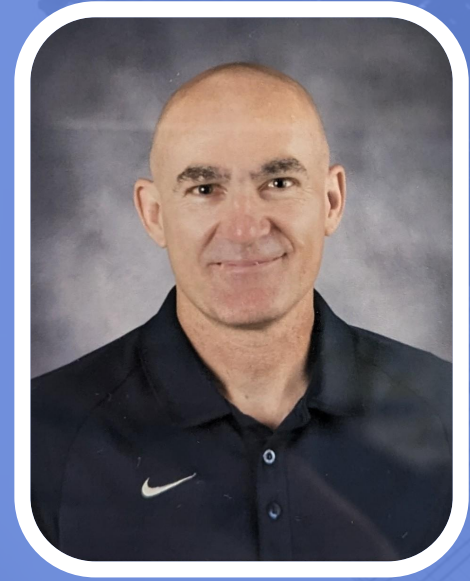
