## FACILITIES condition

Each year, our Maintenance Department conducts a detailed condition assessment for each of our buildings and schools. The detailed report for each school and the building components within each school can be found on our [district website](#).

The overall assessment ratings for each school are:

Anderson Island Multipurpose Building: 93.34%  
Cherrydale Primary School Main Building: 90.95%  
Chloe Clark Elementary School Main Building: 91.88%  
Pioneer Middle School Main Building: 92.91%  
Saltar's Point Elementary School Main Building: 91.56%  
Steilacoom High School Main Building: 89.69%

*Note: Modular buildings do not receive formal condition assessments and are evaluated separately by the Maintenance Department.*
