Why the JIS EAL Program?



Integrated Approach

Across all levels of proficiency, students benefit from a co-teaching model, where EAL Specialists and classroom teachers work together to develop academic language within all subject areas. This approach ensures that every learner thrives in their language development while actively engaging in the broader curriculum.



Regular Feedback

Timely updates on your child's progress through regular reporting and individual parent meetings.

Program Fee

There is a one-time fee of **IDR 89,148,000** for the EAL program. This fee covers the ongoing language support services provided throughout your child's time in the program.

What It Looks Like

Elementary School

EAL support in the Elementary School is provided through a co-teaching model, where EAL Specialists and classroom teachers work together to embed academic language development into all subject areas. For children new to English, foundational instruction is provided on a pull-out basis for at least one quarter to build essential skills while they continue to participate in co-taught classes. After this period, students may transition out of foundational support based on their progress and readiness for fully integrated classroom instruction.

Middle School

To provide the appropriate level of support in mastering English language content, students in the EAL program may be enrolled in a co-taught English class, which is determined by the level of support they need. Additionally, students take an elective class that utilizes one-on-one and small group conferencing to enhance language development aligned with core academic content.

High School

Grade 9 EAL students take Language Enhanced (LE) English and social studies, along with Academic English, which builds crucial academic language skills. In grade 10, students may continue with LE and Academic English before transitioning to mainstream courses in grades 11 and 12. Throughout high school, students are monitored and can receive additional one-on-one or small group support as needed.

Note: There is a minimum English language requirement for Middle and High School students.
