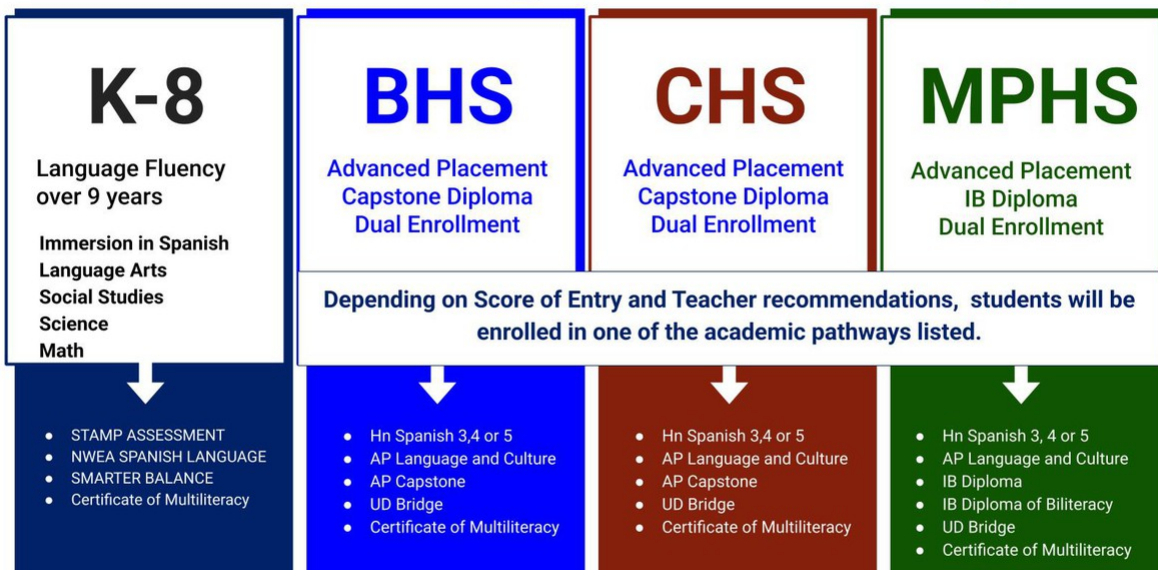

Immersion High School Offerings



If your student attends any BSD High School they will be able to continue with immersion.

Benefits of Continuing in Immersion

Continuing in the high school immersion program gives students the opportunity to **strengthen their language skills** and prepare for success in college and beyond. Students can take advanced courses that offer **University of Delaware college credits**, giving them a head start on higher education while still in high school. This not only **saves time and money** but also allows students to maximize the benefits of their learning.

Additional advantages include:

- Gaining enhanced cultural knowledge and global skills
- Developing critical thinking and problem-solving abilities
- Earning college credits that reduce the number of courses needed after graduation

By staying in the immersion program, students can make the most of these academic, financial, and personal opportunities.

Earn College Credits in High School and Save in Tuition!

Families can save up to \$10,530 in College Savings when their students earn college credits while still in high school.

AP Spanish Language and Culture Exam
