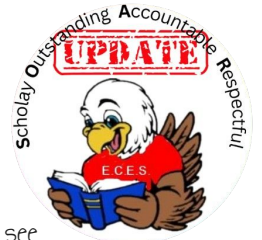
## SOAR NEWS for March:

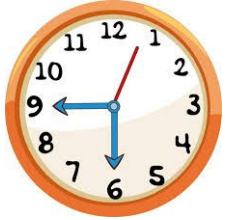

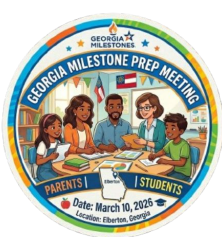

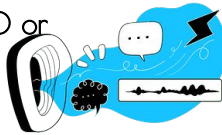
