Eligibility Check and Tickets Sales:

Monday, April 20, 2026 to Friday, April 24, 2026 ONLY

(Ms. Tallarico is not available during 5th period)

Tickets will be sold during lunch periods. Cash only. Checks will not be accepted. See below for procedures and requirements. **Please do not ask, there are no exceptions!**

Eligibility Check and Tickets Sales Procedures:

1. **Student/Parent/Guardian Responsibility:** Check Infinite Campus for: unexcused absences, tardies, discipline assigned, and grades. Submit all excuses (absence or tardies) to the office, serve all discipline assigned and earn passing grades in at least 4 yearlong courses from now until eligibility week. Print Information Packet with Registration Form AND Eligibility Card from school website or pick up packet outside room 131(Ms. Tallarico's room).

Required: 2 Forms (Registration and Eligibility card) completed + Guest Forms and ID submitted (if applicable) = Stamp of Approval to buy ticket

ANY NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENTS

-must email Ms. Tallarico to make all arrangements and adhere to same guidelines: submitting forms/making payment.

2. **Registration Form:** Complete the information on the Prom Registration form (1 form per couple or 1 form for single). (Registration form and Eligibility Card are double sided on 1 page). Registration form will be stamped once all steps/requirements are completed. A stamped registration form is the only way to purchase tickets. **Must be completed Monday, April 20, 2026 to Friday, April 24, 2026 ONLY. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

***Grand March:** You MUST indicate on registration form whether you are interested in participating in the Grand March ceremony at the AAHS auditorium. Please make sure name listed on registration form is spelled correctly, written neatly and the name you want when you are being announced on stage.

3. **Eligibility Card:** Fill out name and grade level in pen. Please print clearly. Drop off eligibility card in main office-they will check attendance, discipline, and Citizenship test completion (for seniors only). If you are ineligible to attend due to attendance/discipline/citizenship test issues, the office will notify you. The front office will give Ms. Tallarico your eligibility card and she will check your grades and EVERFI completion (grade level requirement only). Please stop by and confirm receipt and approval in approx. 24 hours after you turn in the eligibility card. **Must be completed Monday, April 20, 2026 to Friday, April 24, 2026 ONLY. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
4. **Guest Forms and ID:** Please see Guest procedures on the next page. All guest requirements must be completed to get the stamp of approval to purchase tickets.
5. **Stamp of Approval on Registration form:** If student meets all eligibility requirements, the students' registration form will be stamped. Students will pick up registration form from Ms. Tallarico. **Must be completed Monday, April 20, 2026 to Friday, April 24, 2026 ONLY. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
6. **Buy Ticket:** Students will take stamped registration form and money to lunch and buy your ticket! **Must be completed Monday, April 20, 2026 to Friday, April 24, 2026 ONLY. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
7. **Pick a Table:** Tables must be selected when purchasing your ticket. You cannot sign up for a table without purchasing your ticket. It is important to buy your ticket with your group/at the same time. 10 people to a table.

****Junior Class reserves the right to make changes to table assignments****

Eligibility Requirements per Student Handbook

1. **Academic Eligibility:** Students must be passing 4-one credit classes (yearlong course), if not, they are ineligible to attend the dance. Please check Infinite Campus before eligibility check. This is the same requirement for sports eligibility and all other dances. **Please do not ask, there are no exceptions!**
2. **Attendance Eligibility:** If a student has 10 or more unexcused absences, students are ineligible to attend the dance. Please check Infinite Campus before eligibility check. **Please do not ask, there are no exceptions!**
3. **Disciplinary Eligibility:** All assigned disciplinary actions (time) must be served. If there are any outstanding disciplinary actions (time), students are ineligible to attend. Please check Infinite Campus before eligibility check. Any disciplinary actions on or after eligibility check will be determined by Administration for eligibility. **No refunds will be provided. Please do not ask, there are no exceptions!**
4. **Citizenship Test:** All seniors are required to complete the final exam in U.S. Government course called the Citizenship exam. This is a requirement for traditional or nontraditional students-in person, cyber, transition, etc. Please see your teacher of record for directions to complete or confirm completion.

Guests

- Prom is for AAHS Juniors and Seniors. A 10th grader may attend if going with a AAHS Junior or Senior only, so it is limited to grades 10th, 11th, and 12th. A 10th grader may **not** attend with a guest from another school that is in 11th or 12 grade.
- All Juniors and Seniors are permitted to attend the dance with a guest (a non-Ambridge high school student or adult). **No guest may be over the age of 20.** However, the guest will need to submit required paperwork, ID and be approved before you purchase a ticket. Any failure to follow procedures, provide necessary paperwork/ID, the school reserves the right to deny approval. **No refunds will be provided.**

Procedures for attendance with a guest:

1. **Provide Identification:** Submit a copy (by email) of the guest's school ID, photo ID, Driver's License or Passport, which will be kept on file for check-in at the dance. If 18 or older, guest must have state issued photo ID or state issued driver's license with current address. **Please do not ask, there are no exceptions!**
2. **Complete guest form**-Print Guest form from school website or pick up a copy outside of room 131.
There are two different guest forms:
 - for a high school student (non-Ambridge)
 - for an adult (not in high school).
 - **High School Student (Non-Ambridge) Guest:** Please print your name on the bottom of the form. Then give this form to your guest-they must have their parent sign and then their school administrator sign and return to Ms. Tallarico. The form and a copy of their ID are due by April 24, 2026 (the last day of eligibility/ticket sales). **NO REFUNDS**-if you purchase a ticket without prior approval or incomplete paperwork you may be denied approval.
 - **Adult Guest:** Please have your guest fill out and return the form to Ms. Tallarico by mail or email by April 24, 2026 (the last day of eligibility/ticket sales). **NO REFUNDS**-if you purchase a ticket without prior approval or incomplete paperwork you may be denied approval.

Grand March

- Participation in Grand March ceremony is optional for Prom attendees. Please indicate on **Prom Registration** form whether you are participating in Grand March. No changes will be made after Friday, April 24, 2026 at 2:30PM. **There are no exceptions, please do not ask!**
- Grand March order is determined by ticket number-Junior Class officers are always first, then in numerical order by ticket number.
- Grand March participants do not need to pay to participate.
- Each participant will receive 2 free tickets for family. These tickets will be given to participants May 4-7th. Any additional tickets must be purchased.
- You can purchase tickets at the door for \$5 or Ms. Tallarico will sell tickets in advance for a discounted rate of \$3, May 4-7th ONLY. No sales during 5th period OR on Friday, May 8th. **There are no exceptions, please do not ask!**
- Participants must arrive by 3:30PM. Check-in, then report to assigned room-Band/Chorus by 3:45pm. If you are late, you do NOT participate-final lists need to be made for announcers to start event on time.
- The HS parking lot is reserved for participants and disabled individuals only. Please have family plan accordingly as parking is limited.
- The HS will open the doors to the public at 3:45PM and the ceremony will begin at 4PM.
- All proceeds from the 2026 Grand March ceremony go the Sophomore class for the 2027 Prom.

Professional Pictures

- There will **NOT** be a professional photographer at the Prom this year. There has been a huge decline in sales for professional pictures. This was always an additional cost.

School Rules and Regulations

- All school rules and regulations apply while attending the dance.
- All students and bags/purses/etc. are subject to search upon entry.
- Students who are disruptive, or under the influence of drugs/alcohol will be denied admittance and/or will be immediately removed from venue. Disciplinary action will be taken according to district policy. **No refunds will be provided.**
- Students will not be permitted to leave the dance prior to 9:30 PM, without the consent of a parent or guardian. Students leaving the dance will not be permitted to re-enter. A student who leaves the dance-must also leave the premises immediately.
- Students must arrive by 6:30PM unless there is parent excuse provided no later than Friday, May 8, 2026 by 2:30PM. - Any student who faces **ANY** disciplinary action from the date of the eligibility to **May 8th** could be ineligible from attending the dance. (This includes but not limited to: social probation, tardiness to school, suspension, after school detention, etc.) Eligibility to attend due to a discipline infraction will be determined by Administration. **No refunds will be provided.**
