

Running Start

Running Start is a program that allows 11th and 12th grade students to take college courses. Tuition is paid for by the high school, based on the number of credits a student is allowed. These credits are determined by the number of classes (or FTE) a student has at the high school. Fees, books and transportation are the responsibility of the students.

Students are expected to follow the steps for New Students on the college Running Start web sites for application, placement, class registration and orientation, etc.

The Career and College Readiness Coordinators assist students with their quarterly Enrollment Verification Forms. These are typically completed two to three weeks prior to when the college class registration starts for the next quarter.
