We recently supported the Pennsylvania State Police by allowing them to utilize the former PVIS building as a two-day active shooter training site. They were very appreciative of the opportunity to train in a real, unoccupied school facility.

Maintenance and custodial staff continue working closely with PVS staff to ensure the building is running smoothly. As this is still a relatively new transition, teams are continuing to learn the day-to-day operational needs and make adjustments to improve efficiency.

This winter has required significant snow removal efforts. Our crews have become very efficient at mobilizing quickly and ensuring facilities are cleared and ready for safe operation.

We are currently working on two state-funded grant opportunities for facility upgrades at Salisbury Elementary and Paradise Elementary.

Our grounds crew is beginning preparations for the upcoming spring sports season, including field readiness and general seasonal maintenance.

On a less positive note, we are still addressing several roof leaks at PVS, along with a few mechanical failures and cosmetic issues. However, plans are in place to address these concerns, and many of the repairs and replacements will be completed under warranty.
