**APPOINTMENT of DR. ROY BISHOP AS NEXT SUPERINTENDENT OF GPPSS**

A regular meeting of the Board of Education (the “Board”) of the Grosse Pointe Public School System (the “District”), County of Wayne, State of Michigan, was held in the District on the Ninth of March, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member \_\_\_\_\_ and supported by Member \_\_\_\_\_.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Grosse Pointe Public School System is vested with the authority to employ a superintendent of schools pursuant to the **Michigan Revised School Code, MCL 380.1229**, which provides that a board of a school district shall employ a superintendent who shall not be a member of the board and who shall serve under a written employment contract; and

WHEREAS, **MCL 380.1229** further provides that the superintendent’s employment shall be governed by a written contract approved by the Board of Education and that such contract shall not exceed a term of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is authorized under the **Michigan Revised School Code, including MCL 380.11a and MCL 380.1201**, to exercise general powers necessary for the governance and administration of the school district and to employ personnel necessary for the proper operation of the district; and

WHEREAS, at its **February 9, 2026 Regular Meeting**, the Board of Education accepted the retirement of **Dr. Andrea Tuttle**, Superintendent of the Grosse Pointe Public School System, effective **September 1, 2026**; and

WHEREAS, at the **February 9, 2026 Regular Meeting**, the Board of Education received a presentation from the **Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB)** regarding available superintendent search and selection processes; and

WHEREAS, at its **February 23, 2026 Regular Meeting**, following consideration of the process options presented by MASB, the Board of Education adopted a motion to proceed with a **direct appointment process** for selecting the next Superintendent of the Grosse Pointe Public School System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined that **Dr. Roy Bishop**, currently serving as Deputy Superintendent, possesses the experience, qualifications, and leadership necessary to serve as Superintendent of the Grosse Pointe Public School System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Grosse Pointe Public School System hereby appoints **Dr. Roy Bishop** as **Superintendent of Schools**, effective **September 1, 2026, subject to the successful negotiation and approval of a written employment contract by the Board of Education**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education authorizes the **Board President, in consultation with legal counsel for the District**, to enter into negotiations with Dr. Roy Bishop regarding the terms and conditions of an employment agreement consistent with applicable law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any proposed superintendent employment agreement resulting from such negotiations shall be presented to the Board of Education for review and approval at a public meeting in accordance with applicable law, including the **Michigan Open Meetings Act, MCL 15.261 et seq.**
