MEMORANDUM

RE: District Financial Report FY26

-
- Our unexpended / unencumbered balance is \$2,701,061 at the end of February (2/3rd of the way through the Fiscal Year. This is \$422,566 less than what was reported as of the December 31st report.
 - The Special Education Out of District Tuition and Transportation lines have now been allocated appropriately. In previous reports, we had over-encumbered the Circuit Breaker lines by \$272,438. This has been rectified by updating purchase orders that were currently encumbered under Circuit Breaker and have now been moved to the LEA Out of District Tuition and Transportation Lines.
 - We are in the process of encumbering all known or anticipated expenses through the remainder of the year. Once that is completed (estimated 3/6), we intend to freeze future purchasing unless it is an emergency purchase (which will require approval of the Superintendent). Our intention with the "budget freeze" is to estimate an approximate amount of surplus at the end of the year. The School Committee would then direct the School Department on the disposition of available funds. This typically occurs in late May / June. Some options include making one time purchases, pre-paying Special Education Tuitions and/or returning funds to the Town.

Attached is the line-by-line report for FY26 expenditures vs budget through December 31, 2025.
