Traffic Safety

If your student is at least 15 ½, they can get their permit at the DOL.

Prerequisites:

- Obtain WDL Number (this will be requested via ParentSquare prior to scheduling your student in the class this April—you can do it now!)
- Solid attendance patterns semester prior to enrollment in course
- Prioritized by age—must be 15 ½ when the class starts or have permission

Research shows that teenagers who take a driver's education class are much safer on the road. This semester-long course will focus on traffic safety education (TSE) and personal finance through a blended semester developing student independence.



This class is scheduled in age order based on student course requests. Students who wish to take Driver's Ed (TSE) next school year MUST request the class through this class registration process: BUS278 FINANCE/TSE.

Limited Driver's Ed spaces will be offered this summer. If your student is already 16 and wants to take the course in the summer they should NOT request Driver's Ed as a class for next year. Information about summer sign-ups has been communicated via ParentSquare and is posted on our website. If students who request summer don't get the class, we will request a school year spot for them. If students have requested a school year spot, they will not have priority for summer spots.

Summer Schedule- June 8-July 17, M-Th, with Friday availability for retakes PLUS two 2-hour drives per week. ONE fast-paced session available: 9:15-11:30. With limited make-ups available, students must attend all days.

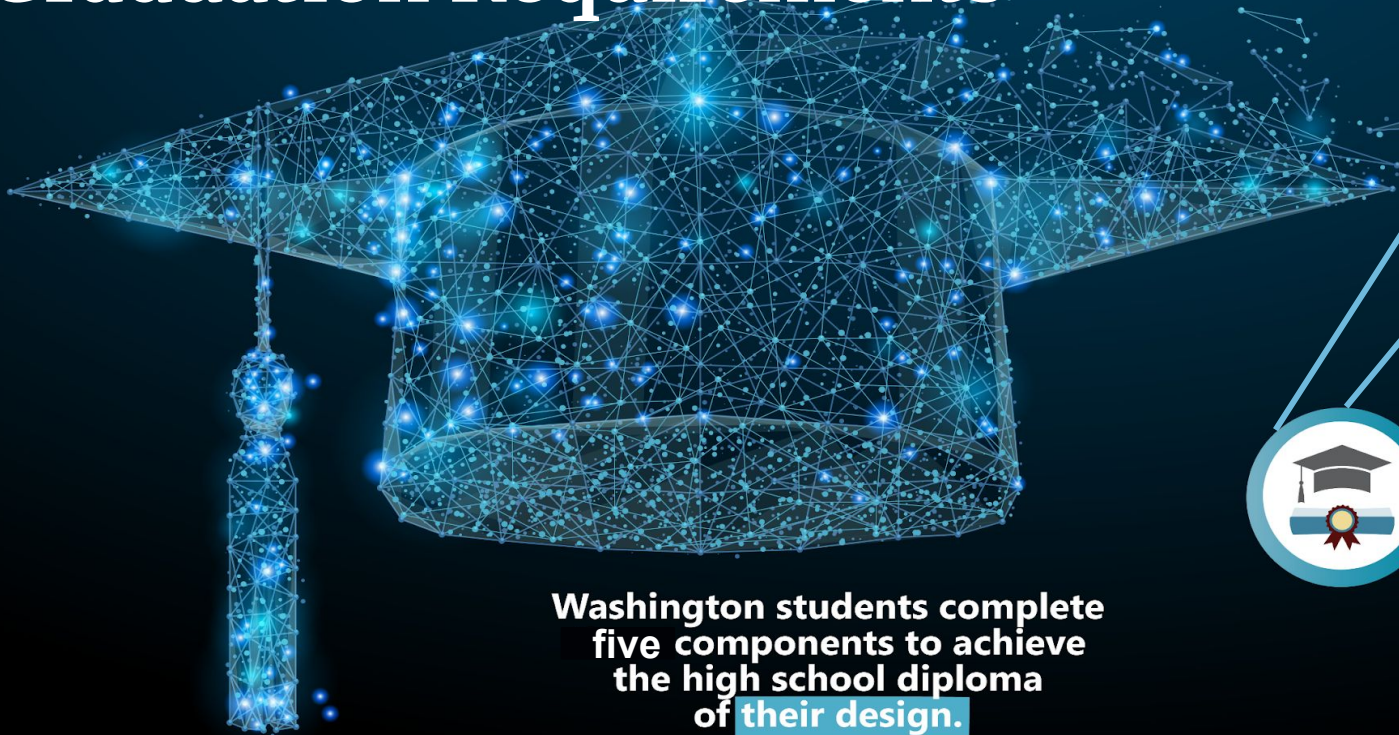

Si los estudiantes que solicitan la asignatura de verano no consiguen la clase, les solicitaremos un espacio para el curso escolar. Si ya han solicitado un espacio para el curso escolar, no tendrán prioridad para las de verano. The purpose of a high school diploma is to declare that a student is ready for success in postsecondary education, gainful employment, and citizenship, and is equipped with the skills to be a lifelong learner. (RCW 28A.230.090)
