Catching the Dream Scholarship

Scholarship for indigenous students in MESBEC, NALE, and TBM programs. Scholarship amounts range from \$500 to \$5,000 per year Awarded based on merit. Over 95% of applicants receive a scholarship.

Requirements: Must be an enrolled member with ¼ degree or more American Indian blood from a federally recognized, state-recognized, or terminated U.S. Tribe and intention to attend post secondary institution.

GDTF Horrace Boatwright Memorial Scholarship

San Bernardino Countywide Gangs & Drugs Task Force i2026 Horace Boatwright Memorial Scholarship for graduating seniors who have overcome adversity and are continuing their education at a college, trade, or technical school

Requirements: Scholarship Application. Student Essay. One signed letter of recommendation from a liaison, teacher, counselor, pastor, or community leader (see below) School Transcript (awards are not based on GPA; however, your transcript must show academic improvement).

Requirements: A current transcript of classes and most recent grades, community service hours acquired over the last two years A 500-word essay describing their educational and career plans along with an explanation of why they are deserving of the scholarship; Letter of reference from a minimum of two non-family members (preferably from teachers); and Proof of Victorville residency
