Business- E-Bike Safety Update

- E-bike safety information will be added to the District's Comprehensive School Safety Plan.
- Trustee Rudolph is acknowledged for bringing attention to the importance of addressing e-bike safety in the school community.
- Assembly Bill 1569 proposes requiring students to complete a CHP e-bike safety course before being allowed to park e-bikes on campus (not yet enacted).
- In the meantime, staff are reviewing policies and exploring local safety measures such as education, parking procedures, and campus guidelines.
