

ALLEGANY COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS' SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by the Allegany County Fire Chief's Association to support a graduating student from an Allegany County High School (home schooled students are eligible). This is a one-time \$500 award and will be based both on need and merit. Applicants may be pursuing any career but preference will be given to those planning to work in a fire or emergency service related field.

Qualifications:

1. Must be a member of an Allegany County Volunteer fire department in good standing and provide a letter from the Chief stating such.
2. Must be planning to attend an institute of higher learning in the upcoming college year and pursuing a minimum 2 year program.
3. Must submit a personal letter of application to include your goals, activities, interests and needs.

DEADLINE for completed applications is May 15, 2026 and should be submitted to the Volunteer Fireman's Association Scholarship Chairman at the address below.

The award will be presented at the appropriate award or graduation ceremony for the winner's school.

The winner and his/her parents will be invited to be our guests at the county convention meeting and dinner in July and the winner invited to ride in the convention parade.
