March 11: PTO McTeacher Night @ McDonalds!

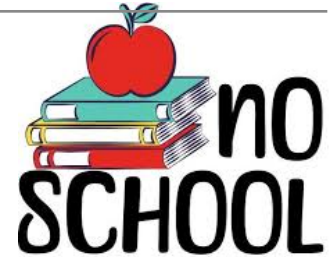

There will be NO SCHOOL for students on Friday, March 13, 2026 due to a scheduled staff professional development day.



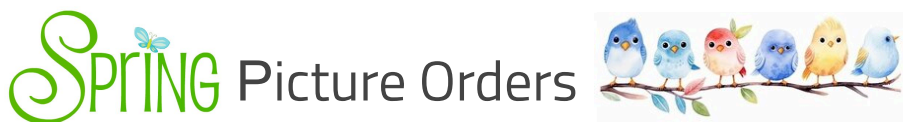

... Attention 6th Grade Parents:

As the school year is starting to wind down, we thought it would be a great opportunity to remind parents of current 6th graders that their child is due for required immunizations prior to entering 7th grade.

As required by The Ohio Department of Health, all students entering 7th grade are **REQUIRED** to have the Tdap vaccine and one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine. Please plan on getting these vaccinations before the start of the 2026-27 school year. You will need to obtain a copy of the most current immunization record (to include Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines) and turn it in to your child's school. Please contact your health care provider or the nurse at school with any questions.
