## **Williamsburg Northside Summer Camp Program**

**(June 29 - August 21)**

Northside Summer Camp runs for 8 exciting weeks, broken into four fun-filled 2-week sessions. This flexible format allows families to choose the weeks or sessions that work best for their summer schedule, while giving campers plenty of time to build friendships, develop new skills, and explore new interests.

Each session is packed with engaging activities, hands-on learning experiences, creative projects related to the session theme. In addition to these activities, Northside Summer Camp provides daily outdoor water play on our spacious rooftop, a variety of special events, music and movement enrichment, weekly sessions with Born Kickers, and gardening in our rooftop garden. Whether your child joins us for one session or all four, they'll enjoy a safe, supportive environment where every day brings something new to discover!

## Sessions and Themes



### **Carnival Celebration (June 29–July 10)**

Step right up and join us for two unforgettable weeks of classic Carnival Celebrations. Children will enjoy the bright sights and sounds of a traditional carnival, filling their days with music, movement, creativity, and fun. Campers will craft game props, create festive decorations, and work together to bring the carnival spirit to life.



### **Olympic Games / Sports Mania (July 13-July 24)**

A high energy 2-week summer adventure where children jump, run, kick, toss, and play their way through their days! Campers will explore activities inspired by the Olympic Games, from track and field and soccer to basketball, gymnastics, and fun international sports. Each day is filled with team challenges, movement games, and hands-on fun, building confidence, coordination, and teamwork. Along the way, children will learn about good sportsmanship, staying active, and team comradery.



### **Camping and Outdoor Adventures (July 27-August 7)**

Our 2-week exploration of outdoor adventures invites children to explore the wonders of nature through hands-on discovery, imaginative play, and outdoor exploration. Campers will build forts, go on scavenger hunts, study forest animals and insects, create simple maps, tell stories around the campfire, and practice basic outdoor safety skills. This dive into the outdoor world will help foster curiosity of the natural world, and teach problem solving and respect for the environment. Campers will celebrate their learning with special campfire songs and a joyful end of camp celebration as proud little explorers.



### **Our Big World Kitchen (August 10-August 21)**

During the final two weeks of camp, we'll take campers on a delicious adventure around the globe! Children will explore a variety of countries through hands-on, no-bake recipes that are simple, colorful, and full of flavor. From rolling sushi to layering parfaits and mixing tropical smoothies, campers will experience the joy of tasting, creating, and sharing food together. As we cook, we'll also learn about the cultures, traditions, and unique ingredients that make each destination special. It's a fun and engaging way to celebrate the diversity of our world—one tasty bite at a time!



## **Enrichment Offerings and Descriptions**

### **Music and Movement**

Our Music and Movement enrichment program brings each summer camp theme to life through rhythm, dance, and creative expression. Children explore songs and movement activities inspired by Circus Fun, Olympic Games and Sports Mania, Camping and Outdoor Adventures, and Our Big World Kitchen, allowing them to connect physically and emotionally to each topic. Through instruments, guided movement, and imaginative play, campers build coordination, listening skills, and confidence. Whether marching in a circus parade, moving like athletes in training, pretending to hike through the forest, or dancing to music from around the world, children experience the joy of learning through music.

### **Soccer with Born Kickers**

Born Kickers provides an entry point to learn soccer and physical education for children ages 2 to 6. Born Kickers has locations in Manhattan, Brooklyn, and Queens. Our structured and fun weekly practices lay the foundation for future success not just to soccer but all sports and learning activities.

### **Gardening**

Our Gardening enrichment program takes full advantage of our rooftop garden, offering children a hands-on opportunity to explore nature in the heart of the city. Campers plant, water, observe, and harvest while connecting their discoveries to each summer theme, from growing ingredients for Our Big World Kitchen to exploring outdoor habitats during Camping and Outdoor Adventures. Through digging, measuring, and observing growth, campers build patience, responsibility, and a deeper understanding of how the natural world supports us every day.

## **Camp Facts**

### **Class Sizes & Ratios**

- Class sizes will range from 8 to 17 depending on the age of the children
- Each class will be assigned one Head Counselor and a minimum of one Assistant Counselor

### **Additional information**

- Diapers, wipes and sun lotion are provided by school
- All meals and snacks will be provided by Northside's Kitchen and prepared by the head chef and kitchen team.
- We are a nut-free program!
- Each class will have a designated area on the first floor for stroller, scooter, or bicycle parking during the camp day.
- Transition schedules for campers who are new to Northside can be discussed with your child's counselor and/or Amanda DiMeo the Head of the Preschool prior to the first day of camp.
- Arrival will be 8:20AM.
- Dismissal will be at 3:30 PM (half-day dismissal at 12:15 PM)

### **Clothing & Gear**

- All campers will have a cubby space in which to keep..a change of clothes, water shoes, sneakers, a bathing suit, a towel, and any other necessary items

### **Nap & Rest**

Resting is not mandatory for rising Kindergarten and older children, but all children will have the opportunity to relax their bodies and minds in a calm, dimly lit environment. Nap and rest periods are designed to meet the needs of each age group.

## **Registration Fees and Refund Policy**

### **Registrations Received By 3/31**

- \$100 deposit per week due during registration
- Installments due 4/15, 5/15, 6/15
- Families may pay in full during registration if preferred

### **Registrations Received Between 4/1 and 4/30**

- \$200 deposit per week due during registration
- Installments due 5/15, 6/15
- Families may pay in full during registration if preferred

### **Registrations Received after 5/1-5/31**

- 50% due during registration
- Remaining 50% installment due 6/15

### **Refund Policy**

- Up to May 1, 2026 if a cancellation is made families may receive a full refund (minus a \$100 change fee)
- Cancellation up to 14 days prior to the start date: families may receive a 50% a refund (minus a \$100 change fee)
