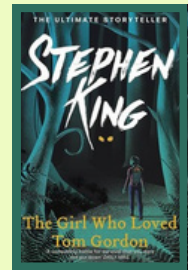
## Book Club & Movie Night













### Author Day

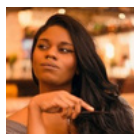
The CHS English Department and Media Center is partnering for an annual event called Author Day.

We are inviting authors to present to all English Classes in the auditorium.

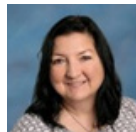

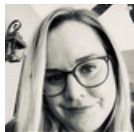
