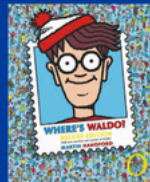

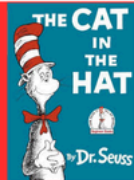

Logging Student Hours

To log student hours, go to tinyurl.com/flastudenthours Make sure you put in your student's full Student ID number on this form. It can be found in your student's profile section when you log into **Campus Parent**. (It is usually a long number, 8-14 digits long. It should be located right near your student's picture.)

To see hours previously submitted, you can go to tinyurl.com/signin-flastudenthours and log in with the student's school Google Account. You can also submit hours while logged in.

*** For older students, I highly recommend having your student log their own hours or do it with you. It's an easy form, and it helps them take ownership of their responsibility to do this.

Links to all these and ways to meet your hours are also on the FLA website on the **Parents** and **Students** pages. Requirements for community service hours and family involvement hours can be found on the website as well.

Logging Family Hours

Log in using the account information you've created. If this is your first time logging in, you'll need to click "Forgot Your Password" and follow the on-screen instructions. You will need to use the same email address you use to get emails from the school. Once logged in, you should be able to see a copy of all of your logged hours, and a summary at the bottom of your family hours and each student's hours. You can also submit hours while logged in.

Family Hours are due May 30.

However, you don't have to log in to submit hours. You can just go to tinyurl.com/flafamilyhours Your family code can be found on **Campus Parent**. Click on the menu icon (the three little lines), then click More, then click Important Numbers. You need the four digit Family Code.

All students in your household should have the same four-digit code. - Students with multiple households may be attached to the other household. That's fine.
