

7-WEEK SPRING ART CLASSES FOR YOUTH

STARTS APRIL 14TH

MONDAYS

TEEN OPEN STUDIO 3:30–5 PM ages 13–18 A space to work on independent art projects outside of school or classes.

TUESDAYS

MATERIAL MAGIC 4–5 PM ages 4–7 Experiment with a variety of materials—paint, drawing mediums, textiles, and found objects—to create unique works of art.

TIME TRAVELERS: ART THROUGH THE AGES 5:15–6:45 PM ages 8–12 Uncover the stories behind great works of art and bring them to life through hands-on projects.

SPRING IS IN THE AIR 4:30–6 PM ages 10–14 Come celebrate Spring and rebirth as we create and discover beautiful spring time phenomena through art making. Students will be painting, using clay, and collage.

WEDNESDAYS

SPRING IS IN THE AIR 4:30–6 PM ages 5–9 Come celebrate Spring and rebirth as we create and discover beautiful spring time phenomena through art making. Students will be painting, using clay, and collage.

CREATING COMICS 101 4:30–6 PM ages 10–15 Learn about heroes, villains, sidekicks, friends, and enemies. Exploring different media, young artists will explore multiple ways to write a story and how to bring it to life with amazing and colorful drawings.

THURSDAYS

KAWAII K-POP DEMON HUNTERS AND FRIENDS 4:30–6 PM ages 5–9 Join the adventure with Huntr/x, Saja boys, Derpy tiger and Sussie to protect the Honmoon. Students sketch & color with different media the beloved characters from Kpop Demon Hunters with Kawaii Japanese art style.

GET CREATIVE WITH CLAY 4–5:30 PM ages 8–12 Students create basic shapes using clay and create small “trompe l’oeil” objects– a.k.a. little clay shoes you can use as flower pots. Students apply different properties of form when sculpting with air dry clay: shape, proportions, and surface texture.

SATURDAYS

PORTFOLIO DEVELOPMENT 1–4 PM ages 14+ Students prepare for competitive admissions into art schools & universities by fostering the development of a cohesive, high-quality body of work. Participants refine technical skills in various media while focusing on personal style, observational skills, and thematic exploration.

CREATING SPACE FOR YOUNG ADULTS FREE WORKSHOPS 4/25 & 5/16 1–4 PM ages 13–18 Students will be guided through community-building exercises and engage in dynamic conversations centered on art. Gallery discussions will highlight the work of contemporary artists who are on view at the Museum. Through informal conversations and hands-on art activities students will deepen their awareness concerning current social issues.
