

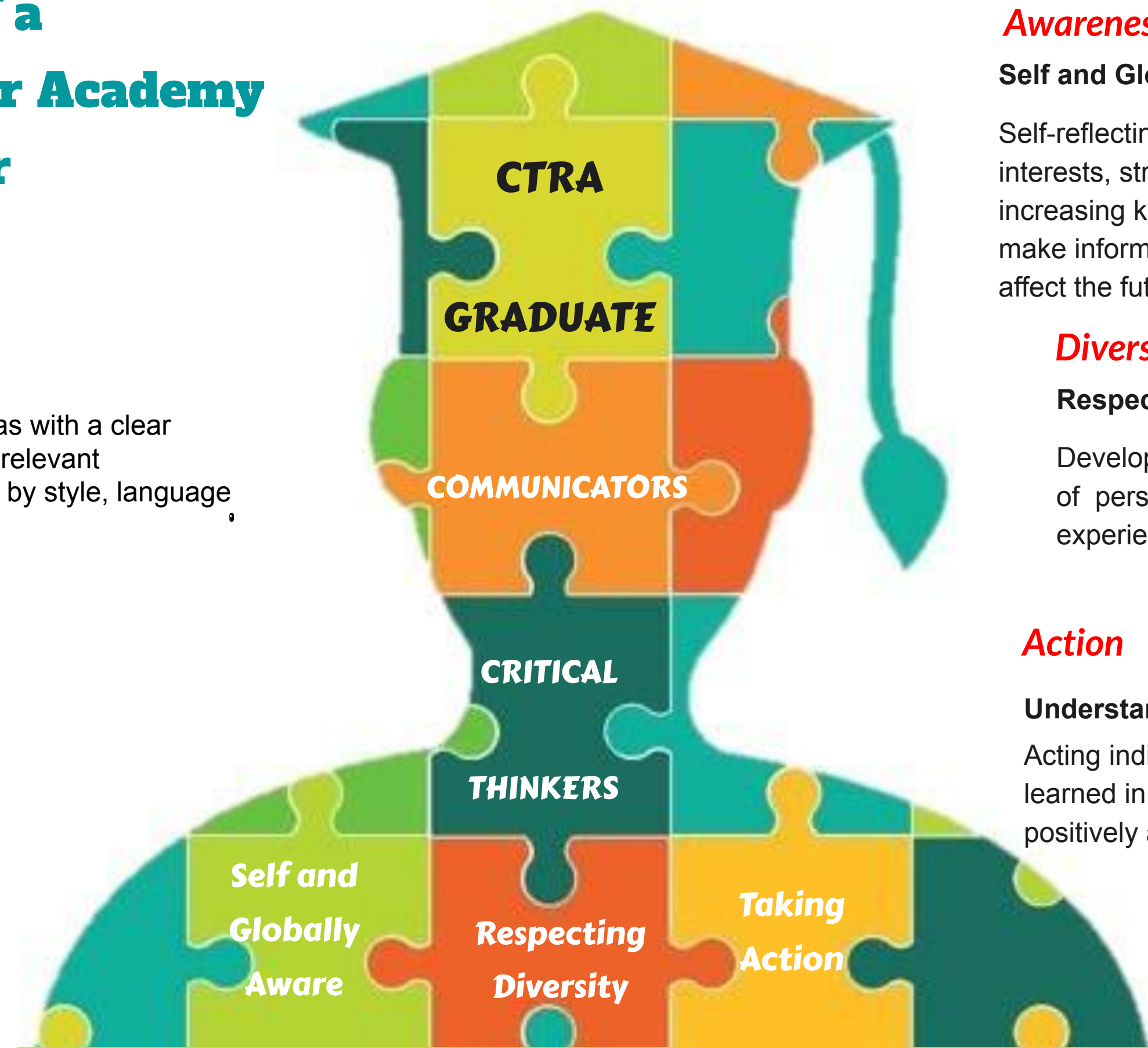
Vision of a Connecticut River Academy Learner
