Booster Success!

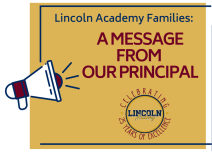

Spring Youth Wrestling at Wheat Ridge High School

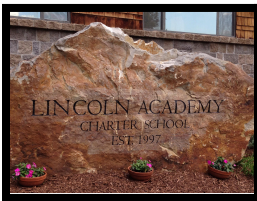
