Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Board of Directors of Vancouver College sets the tuition fees annually based on projected revenues and operating costs. At our recent meeting, the VC Board set the fees for the 2026-2027 school year at \$10,100 per student, an increase of \$400 (4.1%).

Ensuring that Vancouver College continues to be a place where our talented and dedicated teachers and staff can thrive is essential to sustaining the high standards our community values in academics, athletics, the arts, and spiritual life. At the same time, we remain deeply committed to keeping a Vancouver College education accessible to families who desire a Catholic-based learning environment for their sons and to ensure we maintain socioeconomic diversity within our halls. With a tuition increase of \$400 for the coming year, we believe we are thoughtfully balancing these two priorities—supporting the people and programs that make VC special while remaining mindful of the financial realities many families are facing.

Vancouver College also remains proud of its strong Financial Assistance Program, made possible through the generosity and ongoing support of our Alumni and many other members of the VC community. We warmly encourage families who may need support with tuition or co-curricular fees to explore this opportunity. Information about Financial Assistance, including application forms, is available on the school website or through Kelly Lattimer, Director of Finance & Facilities, who can assist families through a confidential process.

The administration, faculty, and staff of Vancouver College are dedicated to supporting each boy within our school community to be the best he can be. On behalf of my colleagues on the Board, thank you for your ongoing support of Vancouver College.
