Dear THS Community,

In accordance with the NJDOE, all 11th grade students must take and demonstrate proficiency on the **New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment-Adaptive (NJGPA-A)**, which includes content aligned to the Grade 10 New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) in English Language Arts and the NJSLS in Algebra 1 and Geometry.

The **New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment-Adaptive (NJGPA-A) for ALL 11th grade students will take place on Monday, March 16th to Wednesday, March 18th.** On testing days, THS will follow the condensed bell schedules below. Students who are testing should arrive at school by 8:00 A.M. and report directly to their assigned testing locations. 11th graders who are late reporting to school for testing are subject to being re-scheduled for make-up exam(s) during classes the following week. Non-testing students should arrive by 11:00 A.M. (on 3/16 and 3/17) and 10:00 A.M. (on 3/18) for their first class. Non-testers who arrive early must remain in the cafeteria until the completion of all testing.

TESTING REMINDERS:

- **ALL students testing MUST bring:**
 - Fully charged **school-issued Chromebook**
 - Chromebook charger
 - **Wired** headphones
 - *Personal devices **CANNOT** be used for testing
- Students will use the built-in calculator for testing and they do not need to bring their own for testing
- **DO NOT BRING** food/drinks, phones/smart devices, coats/bags into the testing rooms
 - All personal bags/backpacks are to be placed in lockers or outside of testing location
- **Tech issues prior to testing?**
 - Go to Technology Room 130 in the high school for assistance **BY Tuesday, March 10th**
- Testing locations will be posted outside the PITT closer to testing
