"A Positive Experience for Police and Youth"

The members of Pennsylvania State Police, Troop C, are proud to announce their sponsorship of CAMP CADET.

The camp is designed to bring a better understanding of law enforcement activities to young people while living in an atmosphere of an actual State Police Training School. Emphasis is placed on self-discipline, and the ability to make new friends and work with them as a team.

***A non-refundable registration fee of \$20.00 is required at the time of application from each child attending the week-long camp. Checks can be made payable to "Citizens for Camp Cadet."*** Additional funding for the program is obtained from local service clubs, businesses, and private donors.



Camp programs include, but are not limited to, radar demonstrations, a first-hand look at a State Police Helicopter, the Special Emergency Response Team (S.E.R.T.), the Federal Bureau of Investigation (F.B.I.), the United States Secret Service, the PA Game Commission, the PA Fish & Boat Commission, the PA National Guard, and other law enforcement agencies.



In addition, swimming, canoeing and other recreational activities will make this an exciting week that will not soon be forgotten.

Check-in is Sunday afternoon, and the week concludes the following Friday evening in a graduation ceremony attended by family and friends.

CAMP CADET applications and the associated registration fee of \$20.00 must be submitted no later than June 1, 2026. After this date, campers will be picked in a random selection from the applications received. In July 2026, all applicants will be notified if they have been accepted/denied to CAMP CADET via mail. If you are selected to attend, **you and your parent/guardian will be required to attend a meeting with camp directors prior to your attendance.**

**NOTE TO PARENTS:** *This is not a camp for troubled teens. If they are interested, please encourage them to attend. If they do not wish to attend, do NOT force them, since this will only hamper our efforts.*

The camp is open to all boys and girls residing within the Troop C coverage area. To be eligible for consideration to CAMP CADET, **a boy or girl must be at least 13 years old, but no older than 15 years old.**



The camp will be held on the attractive campus of Clarion University, located in Clarion, Pennsylvania, off Exit 64 of Interstate 80. Directions to the camp and all other additional information will be provided to those accepted to CAMP CADET.
