# Senior Handbook

*Our expectation for students is proper behavior at all times. Seniors should remember they are subject to the same rules and regulations as any other student while they are present on school property or participating in any school-sponsored activity.*



## **DRESS CODE/OBLIGATIONS/HONORS**

**The following are some reminders to help prevent any last-minute worries:**

- Credits needed for graduation are not certified **until the day of commencement practice**. Therefore, all senior final exams and required classwork must be satisfactorily completed before this time.
- All fees and obligations must be satisfied before Class Day.
- Caps and gowns will be distributed the week of May 5th, as soon as verification that all financial obligations to the school district have been met.
- **Proper attire must be worn for students to participate in the graduation ceremonies.**
- **Girls: Dresses or skirts. The hemline of the skirt/dress should be above the gown length. Black or neutral sandals or dress shoes with a comfortable heel height. Jewelry should be small and tasteful.**
- **Boys: White or solid-colored dress shirt, dark, solid-colored dress slacks, long tie (NO bow ties), and dark dress socks and shoes. NO TENNIS SHOES OR SANDALS.**
- **NO BLUE JEANS, SHORTS, ATHLETIC SHOES, OR FLIP-FLOPS ARE PERMITTED.**



# Look Your Best!!!

Please observe the following guidelines for the wearing of caps and gowns:

- Caps are always worn flat on top of the head with the point of the cap centered in the middle of the forehead.
- Tassels are worn on the **right** side of the cap until the time honors of commencement are bestowed upon the graduate.
- **Caps are never to be worn at the back of the head!**
- Gowns should be approximately ten inches from the floor. Your gown should be neat, clean, and **wrinkle-free** before being worn to any of the graduation exercises.
- Caps may be decorated with a template provided by Mrs. Roth for **Class Day only!** Caps must be uniform and **undecorated** for Graduation.
