The following documents are required for registration:

- __ Birth Certificate:** You must present the original birth certificate with a raised seal.
- __ Proof of Residency:** *TWO different utility bills are required **OR** a copy of your home mortgage/ lease agreement.
- __ Student Information Sheet** Completed with phone numbers and addresses of all contacts.
- __ Home Language Survey**
- __ Immunization Records:** Your child must be up to date for their age based on NH state laws for public school admissions. These will be reviewed by the school nurse.
- __ Health History Form:** *Students with diagnosed health conditions such as asthma or allergies will need to complete additional forms and provide a physician's action plan.
- __ Physical Examination Forms:** Students must provide a copy of an up to date physical.

PLAY PAL PROGRAM CONTRACT 2026/ 2027 SCHOOL YEAR

Dear Families,

Thank you for your interest in Play Pals. Our program is part of Nashua School District's Special Education Preschool. The Program offers a developmental learning approach where children ages 3 to 5 come together to learn.

SESSIONS: Play Pals are divided into two sessions. Children three years of age by September 30, 2026 will attend the morning session. Children four years of age by September 30, 2026 will attend the afternoon session.

DAYS: Children attend Play Pals on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday

HOURS: Sessions are 2 ½ hours per day. The morning session is from 9:15 am to 11:45 am. The afternoon session is from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm. Any changes would be updated by August 2025.

TUITION PAYMENTS: The tuition is \$240.00 each month. Tuition is due the first of each month and no later than the 10th of each month from September through May. Please put your child's name in the memo section of your check. Checks are made payable to the **Nashua School District** and should be sent to:

- * A non-refundable \$25.00 registration fee is required. This does **NOT** apply towards a tuition payment.
- * Please note that the Nashua School District does **NOT** send out monthly payment reminders.
- * Continuous payment of tuition is still due for family vacations, illness or inability to get to school on your part.
- * A student's Play Pal spot will be relinquished if payments are not received by the 10th of the month after two months.
- * NSD Employees and the second child of families with multiple children attending the same school year are eligible for a 50% tuition reduction.

Medical Documentation: The following documentation is required for registration.

Children must have proof of all NH State required immunizations, documentation of immunity, or valid exemptions, to be enrolled in any New Hampshire school according to NH State Law RSA 141-C.

All immunizations must meet minimum age and interval requirements for each vaccine. A 4-day grace period is allowed; however, live attenuated vaccines (MMR, Varicella, or nasal influenza vaccine) that are not administered on the same day, must be administered at least 28 days apart.

DTap/DTP: 3-5 doses with the last one given after age 4
Tdap: 1 dose for entry into 7th grade **Polio:** 3-4 doses with the last one given after age 4
Hepatitis B: 3 doses **MMR:** 2 doses **Varicella:** 2 doses

A child may be “conditionally” enrolled when the parent or guardian provides:

1. Documentation of at least one dose for each required vaccine; AND
2. The appointment date for the next dose of required vaccine.

Children who are entering school for the first time must have a physical examination within the year of enrollment or proof of a doctor’s appointment to have a physical examination before the child is enrolled.

For new students moving into the Nashua School District, an immunization record and a current physical examination are required. There is a 30-day grace period to obtain the physical examination for new students.

The Nashua School District will audit all immunization records prior to enrollment.

Registration Documentation: The following documentation is required at registration.

- Original or certified Birth Certificate or other legal document that includes student’s name, date of birth
Passport, court documents, adoption papers, I-94 are accepted.
- Immunization Record
- Medical Physical Examination within Year of Enrollment
- Proof of Residency [in parent/guardian name(s)]
 - o Two different recent utility bills (electric, cable or gas bill) or
 - o Current lease agreement or Mortgage agreement
- If parent/guardian is unable to provide proof of residence, please call the Welcome Center at 603-966-1080 to determine next steps, which could include Host Residency documentation or McKinney-Vento eligibility.
- Legal Paperwork, if applicable (guardianship, court decree, court placement)

Only the child’s parent or legal guardian can register his/her own child for school.
Photo ID will be requested at time of registration to confirm.

Students attending Nashua Public Schools must be legal residents of the City. Legal residence can be verified by producing two current utility bills and any other documentation deemed necessary by the administration. If a student moves out of Nashua during the school year and wishes to continue attending school in Nashua, the School District must be notified by the student's parents and/or by the student if over the age of 18. If space is available, students will be allowed to remain in the Nashua School District at a prorated tuition. Families who do not reside in Nashua, or move out of Nashua, but send their children to Nashua Public Schools without giving proper notification to the School District and receiving written permission for their child's enrollment in the Nashua Public Schools, will be assessed the cost of tuition for the period of time in question and may face appropriate civil and criminal sanctions, including, but not limited to, complaints for Theft of Services.

Requirements for Enrollment Grades K-12
IMMUNIZATION LAW RSA 141-C

Children must have proof of all NH State required immunizations, documentation of immunity, or valid exemptions, in order to be enrolled in any New Hampshire school according to NH State Law RSA 141-C.

All immunizations must meet minimum age and interval requirements for each vaccine. A 4-day grace period is allowed; however, live attenuated vaccines (MMR, Varicella, or nasal influenza vaccine) that are not administered on the same day, must be administered at least 28 days apart.

DTaP/DTP: 3-5 doses with the last one given after age 4

Tdap: 1 dose for entry into 7th grade.

Polio: 3-4 doses with the last one given after age 4

Hepatitis B: 3 doses.

MMR: 2 doses.

Varicella: 2 doses.

A child may be “conditionally” enrolled when the parent or guardian provides:

1. Documentation of at least one dose for each required vaccine; AND
2. The appointment date for the next dose of required vaccine.

Children who are entering school for the first time must have a physical examination within the year of enrollment or proof of a doctor’s appointment to have a physical examination before the child is enrolled.

For new students moving into the Nashua School District, an immunization record and a current physical examination are required. For these students, there is a 30-day grace period to obtain the physical examination.

The Nashua School District Nurses will audit all immunization records prior to enrollment.
