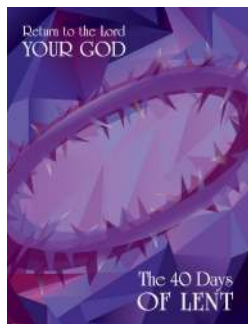

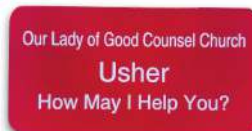

Recurran a Dios del mismo modo, porque no debemos confiar en nuestra propia fuerza, o nuestro propio coraje, para vencer el mal. Si la tentación persiste, ocupen sus pensamientos con cualquier tipo de actividad que sea sana y loable. Cuando ustedes permiten que los buenos pensamientos tengan cabida, que encuentren un espacio en sus corazones, éstos se encargarán de desplazar los malos pensamientos.

o importa qué tipo de tentación los aseche, y no importa el tipo de placer que implique, mientras que ustedes se rehúsen a consentirla ésta no logrará ofender a Dios. Permitan a los enemigos de nuestra salvación continuar al asecho en el umbral de sus corazones, tratando de obtener acceso a ellos. Mientras que el rechazo hacia ellos se mantenga vigente en nuestros corazones, podemos estar tranquilos porque el amor divino, la vida del alma, persiste dentro de nosotros. A través de la oración continua, de los sacramentos, y de la confianza en Dios, nuestra fuerza retornará y todos gozaremos de una vida saludable y feliz.

Caminen con confianza entonces, y manténganse en paz. Vivan bien en medio de la gentileza, la humildad, y la sencillez. Si creen en Dios, y en la verdad de la palabra de Dios, nada puede hacerles daño. Resuelvan no pecar, pero no se sorprendan, ni se dejen perturbar, si caen en el pecado.
