Coverage Start Dates:

- Employment begins 1st–15th → coverage starts 1st of next month
- Employment begins 16th–31st → coverage starts 1st of the following month
- **Teachers starting in fall 2026 → coverage begins October 1, 2026**
- Open enrollment for 2027 begins November 2026

AFLAC Voluntary Insurance

Available through payroll deduction (group rates) during open enrollment or with a qualifying event. Options include:

Retirement

North Dakota Teacher’s Fund for Retirement (TFFR):

- Teacher Contribution: 11.75%
- District Match: 12.75%

Retirement Incentive: 1.5% of base salary for licensed instructors with 10+ years of service who submit notice by December 15.

Life Insurance

\$50,000 term life policy – district paid

Additional coverage available at employee’s cost

VEBA (Post-Employment)

Resigning/retiring employees may transfer leave payouts to a VEBA account (WEX), tax-free, for qualified medical, dental, and vision expenses.

Flexible Benefits Program (FSA)

Plan Year: January 1 – December 31, 2025

- Medical Spending Max: \$3,300
- Dependent Care Max: \$5,000
- Minimum: \$250
- Carryover: \$50–\$660 to 2026 plan year
- Open enrollment for 2027 begins November 2026

Long-Term Disability

District pays entire premium

Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

Confidential counseling for personal/work-life issues

Leave Benefits

Personal Leave:

- 3 days per year with a maximum accumulation of 5 days.
- 4 days per year for teachers who have completed 10-14 years of BPS teaching experience with a maximum accumulation of 5 days.
- 5 days per year for teachers who have completed 15 or more years of BPS teaching experience with a maximum accumulation of 5 days.
- Part-time staff (50% or more) receive personal leave days prorated to the percentage of their contracts.
- Teachers with more than 5 days of personal leave on June 30 will be compensated a rate of \$120 per day for each day exceeding 5 days.

Sick Leave:

Contract Length	Days per Year	Max Accumulation
9–10 months	12	190
11 months	13	190
12 months	14	190

Part-time staff (50% or more) receive sick leave days prorated to the percentage of their contracts.
