

# Parents Right to Know

Our school receives federal Title I funding to support student learning. Under federal law, parents have the right to request information about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher(s).

If you request this information, the school will provide the following:

- Whether the teacher has met the state qualifications and licensing requirements for the grade level and subject they are teaching.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status where state requirements have been waived.
- The teacher's college major, area of study, and any graduate degrees or certifications they hold.
- The qualifications of any paraprofessionals providing services to your child.

In addition, parents may request:

- Information about their child's level of achievement on state academic assessments.
- Notification if their child is assigned to a teacher who is not considered "highly qualified", or if the student is taught by a teacher who is not highly qualified for more than four consecutive weeks.
