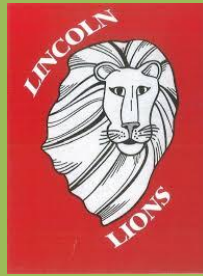

March 8, Wind Event

Dear Friends and Neighbors of Lincoln Elementary,

Following the significant wind event on March 8, Lincoln Elementary sustained considerable damage when a portion of the roof was torn away, causing insulation to be released into the surrounding area.

We want to share a brief update and some reassurance with our community. Lincoln's roof was replaced in 1998, and at that time insulation work was completed by locally owned Klinefelter's Insulation. Because this trusted local business is part of the Great Falls community, Great Falls Public Schools and Great Falls Fire and Rescue were able to quickly confirm that the material released was cellulose/fiberglass insulation and **not asbestos**.

Restoration and cleanup efforts at Lincoln and the surrounding neighborhood will continue in the coming days, and we will share updates and photos on our district website as work progresses. Thank you to our neighbors for supporting the Lincoln Lions and for your patience as we clean up the mess that Mother Nature created.
