Dear McConnell MS Parents and Rising 7th grade Students,

We are excited to offer a high-school Level I Spanish course for the **2026-2027** school year.

We offer this two-year program to our Rising 7th-grade students to give them the opportunity to earn one high school credit (Carnegie unit) in a foreign language prior to entering high school. This course begins in the Fall of 7th grade and finishes in Spring of 8th grade. It is divided into four semesters and students must successfully complete the course to be given the recommendation for the next course level. Students must attain a passing grade in all coursework as well as all final exams administered. Final exams are worth **20%** of the semester grade.

There are many benefits associated with participating in a middle school language acquisition program. Students begin to build cultural awareness and as they master the fluency of the language, they become closer to earning the seal of bi-literacy that is issued by the state of Georgia. Students that enter high school with a credit in foreign language need to only complete one more credit to satisfy graduation requirements. Students that opt to go further in their studies of a foreign language while in high school can earn the option to test out of required entry level world language college courses.

Candidates interested in being considered for placement in the HS Level I Spanish course, please consider the following:

- This is a high school course, and it is taught with the same rigor as any other high school level course.
- Upon successful completion of the course, placement recommendation for the HS Level II course will be added to the student's transcripts.
- The application deadline is **March 09, 2026**.
- Seats are limited.
- Teacher's recommendation is required.
- Parent's signature is required.
- Student's completed application.

Selection is determined using the student's application, current academic grades, and teacher's recommendation. The World Language Department will try to honor your preference but due to class size this is not guaranteed.
