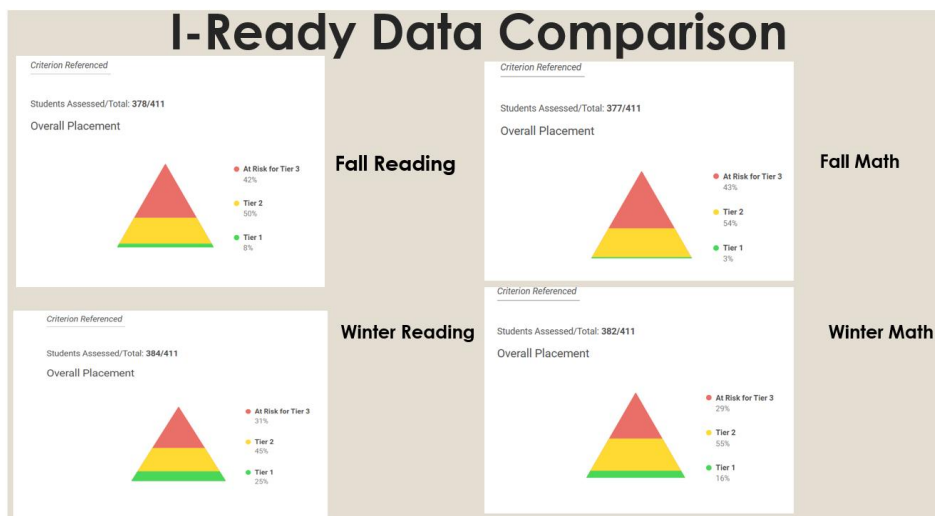

IV. Reports: Discussed Minutes from 2/14/25. Minutes motioned in place and Nicole Jones second the motion.

VI. New Business: Discussed I-Ready Data for the whole school.



Discussed the 2025-2026 SIP Goals:

Goal #1 By May 2026, the percentage of students scoring developing or higher on the state EOG reading assessment will increase from 42% to 50%. The Lexile scores for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades students will increase by 10%. (3rd -29% to 39%, 4th 34%- to 44%, 5th- 57% to 67%)

By May 2026, the percentage of students scoring on grade level on the EOY iReady Math diagnostic will increase from 3% to 20%.

Action Steps:

- Teachers will be trained to implement students goal setting and tracking by guiding students in plotting and interpreting their diagnostic data and academic progress using data notebooks.
- Teachers will participate in monthly peer walkthroughs and implement at least one observed strategy deemed to be effective after debriefing with the admin team.
- Teachers will analyze student data to provide remediation and enrichment opportunities for students . Students' progress will be monitored every 6 weeks by the Data Team.
- Teachers will be trained and will implement research-based technology programs
- (IXL, I-Ready, & Generation Genuis) with the use of goal setting and tracking to monitor progress every 6 weeks. Progress will be documented in data notebook.
- Students will participate in Drop Everything and Read (DEAR) daily .
- Teachers will provide read alouds to improve comprehension and understanding of text.
- Students will track Lexile levels after each i-Ready Benchmark Assessment and record changes in data notebooks.
- Instructional Specialist will use the coaching cycle to help support teachers with implementing GADOE Learning Plans.
- Teachers will progress monitor students on I-Ready Math.
- Teachers will effectively use technology in the classrooms.
- Teachers will attend PL's for math strategies.
- STEAM para will collaborate with math teachers to plan lessons.

Goal #2 By May 2026, the percentage of teachers scoring at level 3 on TKES standard 3 will increase by 5%.

Action Steps:

- Teachers will engage in weekly collaborative planning and monthly vertical planning to develop lessons designed to match the rigor of the standards.
 - Teachers will facilitate/co-facilitate a professional development.
