Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to hear that your child has been offered a place to join Bilton School in September 2026. It is a new and exciting time for you as a family and we have been busy planning the start to the next phase of their education. Our aim throughout this period of transition is to ensure that children, parents and carers feel fully supported and prepared for this next step. With this in mind we have included some useful information outlining the process along with some key dates for your diaries.

The first of these important dates is our **'Welcome to Bilton School'** event, which gives you a chance to meet some of the key members of staff who will be supporting your child's transition and ask any questions you have about uniform, equipment, pastoral care and SEND. The event will run as separate sessions taking place on **Monday 23rd March 2026**.

For this event you only need to attend one session on one of the dates, either from 5.30-6.30pm or 6.45-7.45pm. Our **Induction Days** will take place at Bilton School on **Wednesday 8th July and Thursday 9th July 2026**. The day starts at 9am and finishes at 2.50pm. We request that all children wear their Primary School uniform to the Induction Days and bring a packed lunch with them. If your son/daughter is entitled to free school meals, please email green.l@bil.svmat.uk before 1st July so we can guarantee a packed lunch is available for them. Induction days are a chance for your child to meet their tutor group, familiarise themselves with the school site and to have a taster of the different Key stage 3 subjects offered in Year 7.

We would also like to invite you to a **'Meet the Tutor' event on Wednesday 8th July from 5.30-6.30pm** where you will have the chance to ask any questions and meet your child's form tutor.
