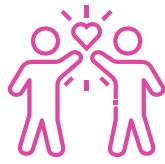

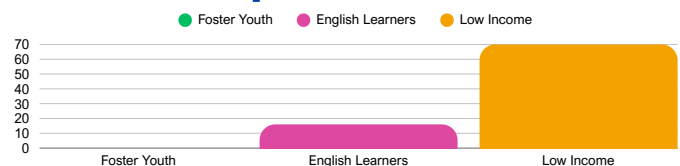
Students groups, such as foster youth, English learners, and low income students make up a significant portion of Oxnard Union's student body.

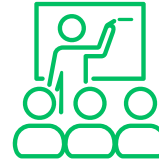
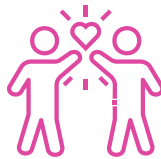
