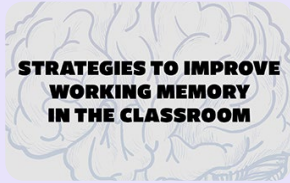

March 29-April 4, 2026

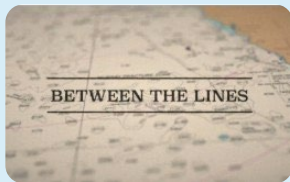
- Explore what working memory is and how it relates to students' classroom success & teachers' classroom management success.
