



Registration for the 2026-2027 School Year Opens TODAY!

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Registration for the 2026-2027 school year begins March 12, 2026! The registration process will take place using your [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#). Once you log in you will click on the link titled - ***Returning Student Registration*** and then be connected to the appropriate registration forms for the upcoming school year.

The registration system includes the current information the school has about your child. You will need to verify and/or correct the information provided. Your child's assigned school for next year is also indicated on the online registration forms. Any questions about your child's placement for the 2026-2027 school year should be directed to your child's current school. Parents may choose to pay using our online payment system - [eFunds For Schools](#). The system **accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover and online checks (ACH) payments**. Information is also included in the registration system for parents to choose to pay in person or via mail using an alternate form of payment (check, cash, or payment plan) or to apply for a fee waiver. Elementary parents are reminded to submit their forms **no later than May 1, 2026**. Students whose elementary registration forms are received after that date may be placed at a different elementary school to balance class size.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

Registration Costs

The basic cost to register your K-5th grade student for the next year is \$154.00. Parents may choose to pay using our new online payment system. The system **accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover and online checks (ACH) payments.** Information is also included in the registration system for parents to choose to pay in person or via mail using an alternate form of payment (check, cash, or payment plan) or to apply for a fee waiver.

Elementary Class Size

To help balance class size at all elementary schools, online student registration submitted after **May 1, 2026** and students new to the district, may be placed at a different elementary school depending on classroom enrollment at each school and in each grade level. Once students are assigned to a school due to overflow issues, the students will continue attending the school to which they were assigned. Any parent who wishes to transfer their student back to their home boundary school or another school will need to complete a special permission form and submit it to the Superintendent's Office. Decisions regarding special permission will be made after the registration process is completed. Priority for special permission will be given to those students who were displaced due to overflow.

School Attendance Areas

Your child's assigned school for next year is indicated on the online registration forms. Please contact your child's school if you have questions about the attendance school assigned to your child.

Not Returning to District 200

If your child will not be returning to District 200 next year, please notify the school office as soon as you make that decision.

Elementary Classroom Assignments

Classroom assignments will be mailed to parents on **Monday, August 3, 2026.**

Bus Information

Bus assignments will be available on the district website a week before school begins on the My Ride App K-12 app. Information on how to access the My Ride K-12 app will be sent to families in August. Families who live outside 1.5 miles from their assigned school may be eligible for fee busing. Fee busing is permitted if a current route is available and there is room on the bus. The cost for this service is \$86.00 one way and \$175.00 round trip per semester. Please contact the Transportation Department 815-338-4777 for eligibility and more information.

Physical Exams and Immunizations

Physical exams and up-to-date immunizations are required for all students entering pre-kindergarten, and kindergarten and for any student entering District 200 from outside of Illinois. **Dental examinations** are required for students in kindergarten and second grade. Students entering kindergarten and those entering District 200 from out of state must also have an **eye exam** completed by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist. Physical, dental and eye examination forms are due on the first day of school.

School Lunch Accounts

"Mealtime Online" is used in all D200 schools to allow parents to view transaction history or deposit funds into their student's lunch account. This is available through our website www.woodstockschoools.org under the QUICKLINKS section. Remaining balances will be transferred to the school your child will be attending in the fall.

Free and/or Reduced Price Lunches and Breakfasts

Families who qualify will receive a Direct Certification letter from the District 200 Food Services Department by **August 3, 2026.** If you **do not** receive this letter and you choose to apply for free and/or reduced price lunches and breakfasts, you may obtain an application online on the District's website at <https://www.woodstockschoools.org/departments/food-services> or at your child's school in August.

Fee Waiver Application and Requirement:

Fee waiver applications will be available in August, in the main office or on the district website. Complete a fee waiver application, attach the necessary proof and send it back to school or the District 200 Business Office. You can put all your children on one form even if they attend different D200 schools. The District 200 Business Office will complete a review of your information and determine what, if any, fees can/will be waived for the 2026-2027 school year. If you think you may qualify, please fill out this paperwork as soon as possible. You will receive a letter notifying you about the status of your application.
