## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR**

### **Registration Costs**

The basic cost to register your student for the next year is \$154.00. Parents may choose to pay using our online payment system - **eFunds For Schools**. The system **accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover and online checks (ACH) payments**. Information is also included in the registration system for parents to choose to pay in person or via mail using an alternate form of payment (check, cash, or payment plan) or to apply for a fee waiver.

### **Health Records and Immunizations**

Physical exams, up-to-date immunizations, and dental examinations are required for all students entering sixth grade and for any student entering District 200 from outside of Illinois. Students entering District 200 from out of state must also have an eye exam completed by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist. Physical, dental and eye examination forms are due on the first day of school.

### **Bus Assignments**

Bus assignments will be available on the district website a week before school begins on the My Ride App K-12 app. Information on how to access the My Ride K-12 app will be sent to families in August.

### **Not Returning to District 200**

If your child will not be returning to District 200 next year, please notify the main office as soon as you make that decision.

### **School Attendance Area**

Your child's assigned school for next year is indicated on the online registration form. Please contact the D200 Transportation Department at (815) 338-4777 if you have any questions.

### **Middle School Informational Meeting and School Supply Drop Off**

A Middle School Informational Meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 6, 2026, at 7:00 pm**, for incoming 6th grade parents and families new to D200 middle schools. On **Tuesday, August 11, 2026**, a Supply Drop Off event will be held for all 6th - 8th grade students. Additional information on the time and locations will be shared prior to each event.

### **School Lunch Accounts**

"Mealtime Online" is used in all D200 schools to allow parents to view transaction history or deposit funds into their student's lunch account. This is available through our website [www.woodstockschoools.org](http://www.woodstockschoools.org) under the QUICKLINKS section. If you have already activated your student's account and he/she attended either one of D200 middle or elementary schools, your student's balance will automatically transfer to his/her middle school.

### **Free and/or Reduced Lunches & Breakfast**

Families who qualify will receive a Direct Certification letter from the District 200 Food Services Department by **August 3, 2026**. If you **do not** receive this letter and you choose to apply for free and/or reduced price lunches and breakfasts, you may obtain an application online on the District's website at <https://www.woodstockschoools.org/departments/food-services> or at your child's school in August.

### **Fee Waiver Application and Requirement:**

Fee waiver applications will be available in August, in the school's main office or on the district website. Complete the application, attach the required documentation, and return it to your school or the District 200 Business Office. If your children attend multiple D200 schools, you may list them all on a single form. The District 200 Business Office will review your information and determine which fees, if any, will be waived for the 2026-2027 school year. If you believe you may qualify, please submit your application as soon as possible. You will receive a letter with the status of your application.

### **Student Schedules**

Student schedules will be available via PowerSchool and mailed home in early August.
