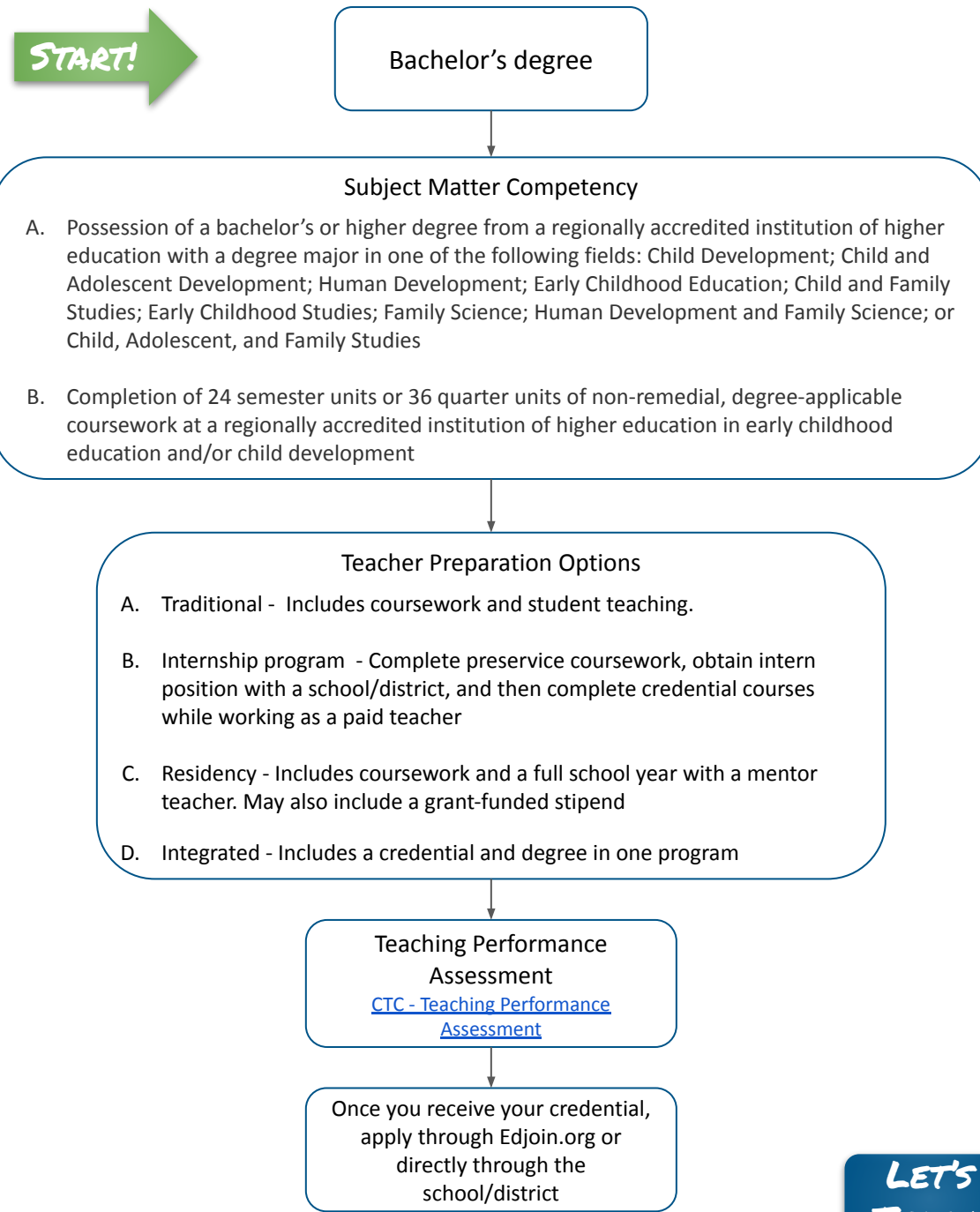


PK-3 Early Childhood Education (ECE) Specialist Instruction Credential - CA
