<p>For the Core 40 with Academic Honors diploma, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Complete all requirements for Core 40. · Earn 2 additional Core 40 math credits. · Earn 6-8 Core 40 world language credits (6 credits in one language or 4 credits each in two languages). · Earn 2 Core 40 fine arts credits. · Earn a grade of a "C" or better in courses that will count toward the diploma. · Have a grade point average of a "B" or better. · Complete <u>one</u> of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Earn 4 credits in 2 or more AP courses and take corresponding AP exams B. Earn 6 verifiable transcribed college credits in dual credit courses from approved dual credit list C. Earn the following: A minimum of 3 verifiable transcribed college credits from approved dual credit list and 2 credits in AP courses and corresponding AP exams D. Earn a combined score of 1250 or higher on the SAT and a minimum score of 560 on math and 590 on the evidence based reading & writing section. E.
