



# Post-Secondary Ready Competencies

Students must complete at least one of the following:

Competency	Description
<b>Honors Diploma</b>	Students who earn the Academic Honors or Technical Honors diploma at the time of graduation will qualify for Bucket 3; See page 11
<b>ACT</b>	Must meet national college-ready benchmarks set by ACT - 18 in English, 22 in Reading, 22 in Math, and 23 in Science. <i>(These scores are subject to change)</i> Students can sign up to take the ACT outside of school, primarily on Saturdays. Sign up at <a href="http://www.actstudent.org">www.actstudent.org</a> .
<b>SAT</b>	Must meet national college-ready benchmarks set by the College Board - 480 in English and 530 in Math. <i>(These scores are subject to change)</i> . Hobart High School administers the SAT to all juniors in the spring of their junior year. Prior to this, students will have the opportunity to take the PSAT, as well as utilize Khan Academy for free SAT practice.
<b>ASVAB</b>	The ASVAB can be taken at local military recruiting offices. Hobart High School may offer it each semester depending on student interest. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A qualifying score of 31 will meet this requirement, along with a completed Intent to Enlist Form.</li> </ul>
<b>State and Industry Recognized Credential or Certification</b>	See Course Descriptions beginning on page 35 or Industry Certifications on page 6. Students must take and pass the Certification test administered by their classroom teacher.
<b>Career-Technical Education Concentrator</b>	Students must take a Next Level Programs of Study three-course sequence and earn a grade average of C- or higher. See pages 29-32 for more information.
<b>AP/Dual Credit courses</b>	If a student is taking AP/Dual Credit courses to meet the postsecondary-ready competency, either: One of the three courses must be in a core content area. Students pursuing liberal arts tracks must have at least one course corresponding with the CTL; <b>OR</b> All three courses must be part of a defined CTE sequence. A defined CTE sequence of courses is based on the Indiana College and Career Pathways. These courses must correspond with the CTE Technical Dual Credit Crosswalk (see counselor for details). For a complete list of Dual Credit courses offered at Hobart High School, see page 15. Grades earned in the dual credit courses must average to a C- or higher.
