This opportunity is available only to current TSD high school students who have been invited to participate in the TSD High School Credit Replacement Program. The program allows eligible students to recover credit for courses in which they previously earned an NC (No Credit), E, or H grade. **Note that letter grades are not issued for credit replacement courses.** The new summer school online learning platform is "Subject". Courses will be completed in the Subject platform (see page 4 for more information). Only courses required for graduation are offered, and students may enroll in a maximum of **two** classes over the summer. Not all courses available through our schools are offered through the CR program; all electives and some core courses are not available for credit replacement. Please refer to the attached list for the courses currently offered.

Before selecting courses, students must meet with their school counselor to discuss their options.

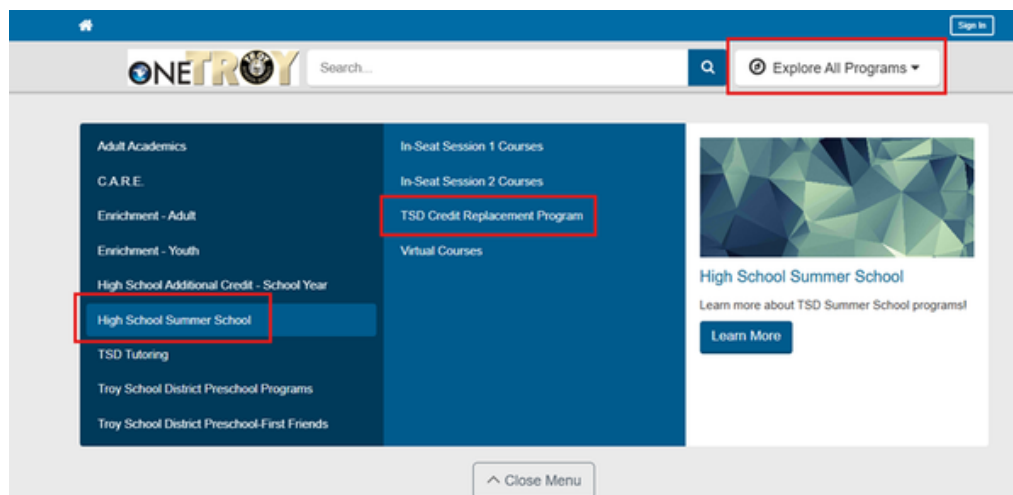

HOW TO REGISTER

ONLINE REGISTRATION OPENS MARCH 2 - CLOSES JUNE 26 [TROY.CE.ELEYO.COM](https://troy.ce.eleyo.com)

- Browse to the website: <https://troy.ce.eleyo.com/>
- Select Sign In (top, right corner) and enter your login credentials.
 - If you are new to our online registration system you will need to set up an account in order to register or make payments. Please complete a profile for your household; adding adults and children under one account. This will ensure you will receive accurate program information for your whole family.
 - If you forgot your password, please use the Forgot Password link to receive an emailed link to create a new password.



Enroll Student for TSD Credit Replacement

- Select Explore All Programs.
- Select High School Summer School.
- Select TSD Credit Replacement
- Select View All courses in TSD Credit Replacement Program
- Select program again
- Select Enroll (on right hand side).
- Choose Attendee.
- Accept Terms.
- Complete question form including selecting which class(es) to take).
- Select GREEN checkout button at top of screen OR view your cart and “check out” (max 2 classes).

CR PROGRAM DATES/INFORMATION

Course Format

- Courses are completed online June 15 - August 7 through Subject (see next page) with support from a mentor teacher - a secure internet connection is required.
- All courses are asynchronous (self-paced) and available 24/7.

Credit and Completion

- To receive credit, students are required to complete their course(s) by August 7.
- Once a student successfully completes the credit recovery course, the NC (No Credit), H or E on the student's transcript will be replaced with a CR (Credit) or G. Letter grades will NOT be given.
- If a letter grade is needed, see regular High School Summer School offerings for regular credit recovery (Earned C, D, or E previously in course - letter grades will be given) option

Optional Academic Support Lab

- An in-person lab will be open at Troy Continuing Education, 1522 E Big Beaver Rd, Troy, MI 48085 (Room 20), Monday–Friday, 8:00 AM–12:00 PM, from June 15 to August 7 - closed on July 2 and 3.
- The lab is staffed by certified teachers for optional in-person help.

- Optional Orientation - Monday, June 15th at 9am via Zoom

Mentor Support

- Each student is assigned a mentor teacher to help guide them through the course.
- Mentor teachers will communicate with students via the email address provided during registration. Make sure this email is active, accurate and checked often to ensure proper communication.

VIRTUAL LEARNING PLATFORM UPDATE

Classes will no longer be offered through Edgenuity. The new summer school online learning platform is "Subject". Courses will be completed in the Subject platform. Throughout the summer, students and families should ensure they have access to Subject and check the platform regularly for assignments. Additional information and support will be provided to help ensure a smooth transition. Registration for classes will still be completed via Eleyo.

Here are a few quick details about the Subject platform:

- Average course time is 50 hours to complete, courses are available to complete with 24/7 access
- Academic videos are each approximately 3-5 minutes long, to support learning engagement
- Spark is the 24/7 AI messenger support for subject area help
- Live Chat platform support is available from 9am-9pm
- Progress reports will be emailed home to families
- No app required
