Every Noblesville school is staffed with school counselors and social workers, and those services will remain in place. Aspire staff will supplement, not replace, the strong mental health supports already available in our schools. This change follows Community Health Network's recent announcement that it will no longer be providing in-school mental health care across the state.
