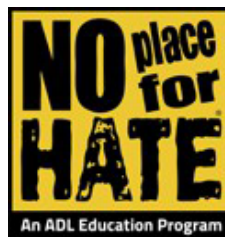


SCHOOL

Somers is a residential, suburban community of approximately 20,000 persons located in northern Westchester County, 45 miles from New York City. A large percentage of the residents commute to jobs in southern Westchester and New York City. GRADING POLICY

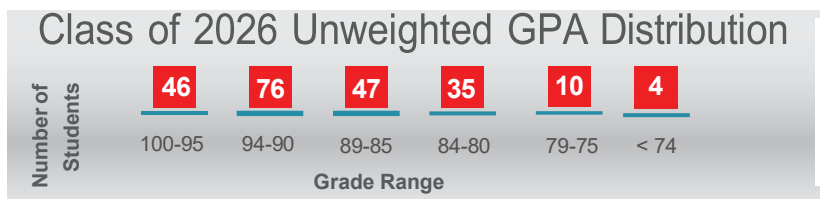

Grades are earned on a 0-100 basis. Grade range: A+= 95-100, A= 90-94, B+= 85-89, B= 80-84, C+= 75-79, C= 70-74, D= 65-69, F= 0-64. Passing grade is a 65 or above.

TRANSCRIPT: Transcripts reflect all numerical and letter grades earned at Somers HS, as well as transfer and credit recovery grades. Credit Recovery and approved courses taken online are recorded as P/F. Both a weighted and unweighted GPA is calculated.

WEIGHTING: AP and IB courses receive an additional 6 points and Honors and DE courses receive an additional 3 points within the cumulative GPA calculation (not in the transcript final average). All subjects except courses graded P/F or listed as IS (Independent Study) are included in the GPA calculation.

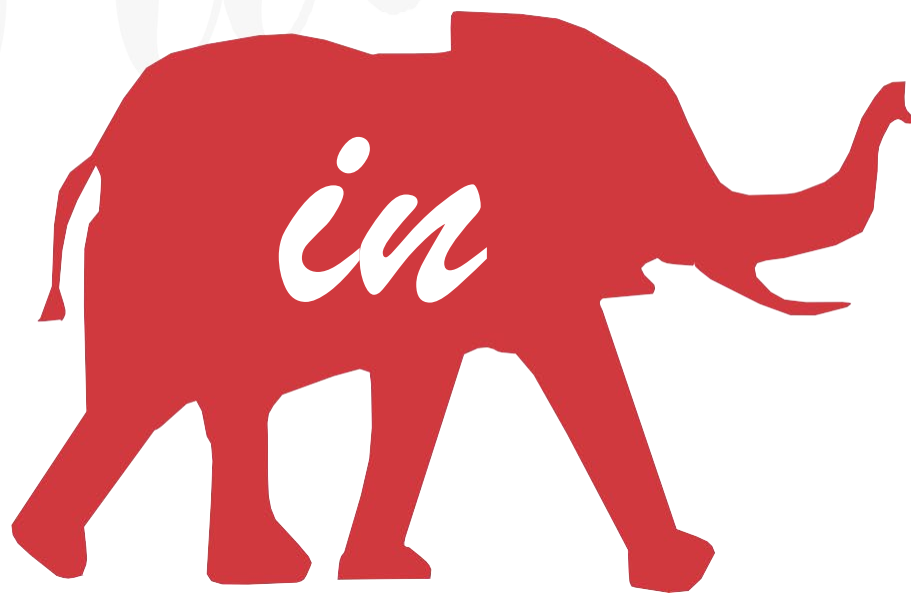
