

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Thursday, February 19, 2026 at the Rockbridge Innovation Center.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown, and Lenna Ojure; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Ashley Rhodenizer, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Berkstresser called the meeting to order at 5:17.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Brown recommended that the Board go into a ***Closed Meeting*** to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Ojure, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the ***Closed Meeting*** at 5:18 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 6:26 p.m.

Trustee Ojure read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Ojure, and seconded by Trustee Brown the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

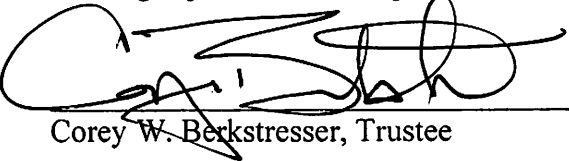

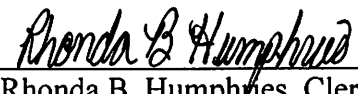
Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Ojure, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2526-094-09 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student is to go to RACSB for intake and services;
2. Student will complete daily check-in with google;
3. Student will receive homebound instruction;
4. School administration will develop plan for student safety;
5. Student will attend Return to Learn meeting in August 2026;
6. Student must provide proof of therapy visits;
7. Student must complete Edgenuity by end of the 2025-2026 school year.
