General Business, Board Reports

- The Board Members shared information regarding their recent site visits, committee reports and other community related activities.

Superintendent's Report

- Student Recognition

- Informational item: the state approved the District's request for allowance of attendance due to emergency conditions (form J13A) for school closures due to the November 4, 2024 Mountain Fire and the December 2024 and January 2025 wind events which caused power safety shutoffs. The CDE approved five emergency days of closure, which may be used to meet the instructional time requirements pursuant to CA Education Code sections 46207 and 46208.
