



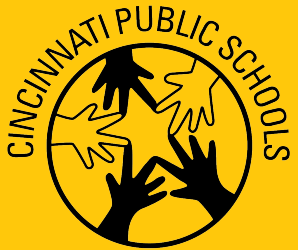

- State Policy - Ohio 3313.60
 - Every school and district should have a physical education curriculum aligned to standards.
- State Policy - Ohio Policy 3302.03
 - PE Assessment data gets reported on district and school report cards.
- CPS Policy - Code 5311 (Wellness Curriculum)
 - PE programs should be high quality using standards aligned instruction and assessment data and legal supports to engage and support all students.
- Can support goals for Athletics in the District's Strategic Plans

PE Recommendations

We piloted QuaverEd PE and SchoolHealth at many schools across CPS.

SchoolHealth is our recommendation for a K-12 PE curriculum.

It meets all of the must haves from the Council and will further support the teachers with having sources of high quality student data from their teacher evaluations.

1 year contract: FY 27 that includes curriculum, assessments, & supports for diverse students (ESL, IEP, and 504)

Pilot teacher and Adoption Committee members would lead PD on this new curriculum March 2, 2026 before full implementation in August 2026. Implementation and PD to be managed by the K-12 Curriculum Manager.

K-12 Health Supports

- **State Policy - Ohio 3313.60**
 - Every school and district should have a health curriculum that meets very specific Ohio specific requirements.
- **State Policy - Ohio 3313.6011**
 - Every school and district must offer specific instruction supporting abstinence and healthy pregnancies.
- **CPS Policy - Code 5311 (Wellness Curriculum)**
 - Health education should cover nutrition, prevention of the use of harmful substances (tobacco, alcohol, and opioids), in addition to STIs, domestic violence sign and prevention.
