Grade Level Highlights:

PreK - We are exploring with shapes, counting with number recognition to 10, and learning about the letter S and identifying initial sounds in words.

Kindergarten - We are practicing words with short vowels (hit, gap), exploring 3D shapes, and they even had a dentist visit to teach them about tooth care.

1st Grade - We will beginning to learn about r-controlled vowels (or, er, ir, ur, ar - car, girl). We've also been working on fractions but will be moving onto time and money.

2nd Grade - We have recently learned about different habitats. Now we are working on measurement in Math and working with adding prefixes and suffixes to base words to create new words in Phonics.

3rd Grade - We have been reading Wild Robot and working on Fractions in Math, moving into measurement & data soon. We are also going to be working on various affixes (prefixes or suffixes) to explore how new words can be made.

4th Grade - We have wrapped on Multiplication & Division, but will continue to review. We will be moving into Fractions & Decimals. We are also continuing to read Wonder in class.

5th Grade - We recently finished Volume and Geometry, and we are moving into Fractions. In Literacy, we have been working on integrating information from multiple sources.

If your child is out sick with the flu or another communicable disease, please call the school nurse before sending them back to school. This helps keep kids from returning to school while still contagious AND it gives us the opportunity to do a deep clean of affected classrooms to prevent further spread.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR STUDENT HOME for:

~ **FEVER** – A temperature over 100 degrees is considered a fever. Students should be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing before returning to school. For fevers over 101 a call to the doctor is recommended.

~ **HEAD LICE** - According to the Department of Public Health and Human Service recommendations, a student with a confirmed case of head lice may return to school after proper treatment. All cases of lice should be reported to the school nurse.

~ **CONJUNCTIVITIS** – (pink eye) - According to the Department of Public Health and Service guidelines, students with crusty, itchy, red eyes with thick yellow drainage should be excluded from school. Once a diagnosis of conjunctivitis is made, the student may return to school after 24 hours of antibiotic treatment.

~ **VOMITING and/or DIARRHEA** - Students should be kept home for any episodes of vomiting or diarrhea occurring within 24 hours of the school day.

~ **STREP THROAT** - In accordance with the Department of Health and Human Services guidelines, students with strep throat may return to school after 24 hours of antibiotic treatment and be free of fever.

~ **STAPH INFECTIONS** - In accordance with the Department of Health and Human Service guidelines, all infections should be reported to the nurse and all open wounds must be covered while at school/school activities.

Students have been learning ways to improve when they are learning a new skill and ways to keep going when they make a mistake or face a challenge. Skills that they continue to work are asking for help, practicing and trying hard.

They also learn that making mistakes can help us figure out what's not working, so we can make changes and try again, and do better next time.

Practice at home:




Notice and praise your child when they are working hard to learn something. Focus on the effort they're putting into learning and the strategies they're using to improve. For example: when they ask for help, when they practice or when they keep trying even through mistakes and challenges. You can say, "you tried really hard and kept practicing so you could learn how to ride your scooter. You're getting better and better!"
