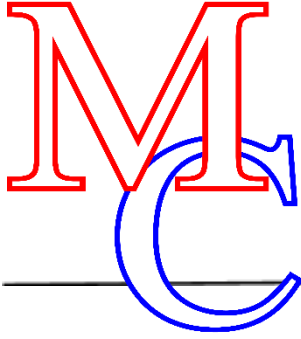

Dear Middle Country Families:

We are pleased to share that i-Ready Parent Reports have been posted to the Parent Portal. These reports are based on the results of the i-Ready Diagnostic and include valuable information about your student's individual progress and growth.

The i-Ready Diagnostic is the district's universal screening tool that is administered three times per year: fall, winter, and spring. It is an adaptive diagnostic, meaning it adjusts question difficulty based on student responses to pinpoint each student's current level of performance. This ensures a unique diagnostic experience for every learner.

Teachers use the results of the i-Ready diagnostic, in addition to other measures of performance, to get a fuller picture of each student's strengths and areas for growth. The diagnostic is also used to design a personalized learning pathway for each student with lessons that students can complete for extra practice.
